SUBJECT: LEO HARVEY OSWALD, etc.

On this date at 6:00 PM, a Mr. TOMMY JACKSON, 5121 E. Berry Street, Fort Worth, Texas telephonically contacted the FBI and advised the writer that he had obtained the following information while visiting in Mineola, Texas over Thanksgiving:

A man answering OSWALD's description was in Mineola a week before the assassination. He stopped in Sharp's Hardware and Furniture Store and asked where he could purchase a pistol. He next went to a shoe repair shop run by Mr. SINCLAIR and had a holster made for a sidearm.

ACTION: Handle as desired.
