

FBI Probes Threat to 3 Senators

The Justice Department on Friday ordered an FBI investigation of a recorded telephone message suggesting that antiwar senators ought to be "shot between the eyes."

The American Nazi Party, now the National Socialist White Peoples Party, lists Sens. George McGovern (D., S. D.), J. W. Fulbright (D., Ark.) and Mark O. Hatfield (R., Ore.) as the vanguard of treason and says in the recorded message they should all be shot.

"McGovern, Fulbright, Hatfield, the whole rotten bunch, need a bullet right between the eyes," says the "white power message" available to those who dial a number at the party's headquarters in nearby Arlington, Va.

The Justice Department said McGovern had asked it to investigate. Department sources said use of the recorded message may violate a Federal law against use of interstate commerce facilities to transmit a threat.
