Re Omaha teletype to Bureau, 1/6/77.

Referenced teletype reported that the Omaha file on the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY, 11/22/63, had been destroyed.

On 1/8/79, [redacted] Omaha, Nebraska, telephone number [redacted] telephonically advised that she had a former friend, [redacted] who in turn, was a friend of [redacted] who was married, but later divorced, [redacted]

After the divorce, [redacted] moved to Dallas, Texas, and resided there at the time of the KENNEDY assassination. She had taken her grandchildren to see the President and witnessed the assassination. [redacted] related that [redacted] had advised [redacted] who in turn, had told [redacted] that the shot came from behind them and they were standing on a "grassy knoll." She indicated she was always curious about this shot inasmuch as it supposedly had come from the book depository. She was not sure whether [redacted] had been interviewed at the time; she has no idea of her present whereabouts. She indicated she was furnishing [redacted]
