

## Mitchell Told To Discuss Alioto 'Leaks'

NEW YORK, June 20 (AP)—  
A state judge today ordered  
former Atty. Gen. John N.  
Mitchell to make a notarized  
statement on July 2 for "a \$2  
million libel suit against Look  
magazine filed by San Fran-  
cisco Mayor Joseph L. Alioto's  
brother-in-law, Rudolph Pa-  
pale.

The 1969 Look article, enti-  
tled "The Mayor and the Ma-  
fia," charged that Alioto and  
Papale were "enmeshed in the  
mafia."

Papale said a deposition  
from Mitchell is necessary to  
determine if he "activated the  
massive simultaneous disclo-  
sure by five federal investiga-  
tive agencies reporting a num-  
ber of alleged Mafia members  
to the Look authors who  
linked them to Alioto" and  
himself.

Papale said he believed the  
authors were given access to  
confidential reports of the  
FBI, the Internal Revenue  
Service, the Federal Bureau of  
Narcotics, the Customs Bu-  
reau and the Immigration and  
Naturalization Service.

Mayor Alioto also filed a  
\$125 million libel suit against  
Look over the article, but two  
trials ended in hung juries.  
On Feb. 2, a federal judge de-  
nied Alioto's motion for a  
third trial.
