SUBJECT: *Assassination of President John F. Kennedy*
JOSEPH L. SCHOTT
Former Special Agent

As you know during our inquiry in Dallas relating to the assassination of former President JOHN F. KENNEDY, former Special Agent JOSEPH L. SCHOTT, author of the book "No Left Turns", was interviewed. Details of this interview were set forth in appropriate FD-302, in view of SCHOTT's refusal to furnish a sworn statement. During this interview, SCHOTT volunteered that he was aware of the fact that the Bureau had recently sent an airtel to our field offices concerning him and that a friend of SCHOTT's, a newspaperman, called him one day to advise that he, the reporter, had a copy of this airtel in his possession and that he read portions of the airtel to SCHOTT.

SAC GUNDERSON was orally advised of this information.
