Corruption Alleged In FBI Under Hoover

WILMINGTON, Del. (AP) — The U.S. attorney is reviewing a Justice Department report on alleged corruption by former FBI director J. Edgar Hoover and some of his top officials, the Wilmington News Journal reported yesterday.

The newspaper said in a copyrighted article that the report accuses Hoover of using money from the employee recreation fund and the FBI informant fund for entertainment and for repairs to his home.
