FBI fined for delays

BOISE, Idaho — The FBI was fined \$1,920 for delays in producing reports and evidence in the trial of a white separatist who was acquitted of killing a federal marshal.

U.S. District Judge Edward Lodge said the FBI repeatedly ignored orders to produce material in a timely manner, delaying the eight-week trial of Randy Weaver and Kevin Harris. Lodge levied the fine on Tuesday.

Defense: FBI created case

NEW YORK — Embarrassed by its failure to heed warnings of a plot to bomb the World Trade Center, the FBI orchestrated a terrorism case against 12 Muslims to salvage its reputation, a defense attorney said on Tuesday.

John Jacobs leveled the accusations in the second day of opening statements in the terrorism trial.

Sheik Omar Abdel-Rahman, 56, a blind Egyptian cleric, is accused along with 11 alleged disciples of plotting to blow up New York City bridges and tunnels, the United Nations and an FBI office.
