

King assassination-similarities

At about 3 pm I got a registered envelope from Fred Nemcomb at the city post office. It contained four sets of pictures of the sketch of the man the FBI seeks in the King assassination and four enlargement of a man in a William Allen picture taken outside the TGBD 11/22/63. The similarities are striking.

I went to the News-Post and gave Harper a set. They are interested. I then phoned AP Baltimore and spoke to Dan Donahue, who spoke to Bureau Chief Marvin Beard, who asked me to mail them to him for forwarding to New York. In the interests of speed and helping solve the crimes, I offered to mail the pictures directly to AP NY, put them on the Greyhound bus to Baltimore or ask Harper to put them on the wirephoto. This he wanted least of all. He insisted on the mailing, and I did that as soon as I left the office.

Earlier I phoned Larry Stern from Ray Wachter's. Larry said he'd pass this up but would like a "re-in check", whatever that can mean.

From the News-Post I phoned the local FBI man. He is away until tomorrow night. I phoned the Baltimore office and finally got an agent who introduced himself, pleasantly, as "What can I do for you". I explained. He also was in no hurry. I had given him my name, so there was little else he could ask.

Now we can all sit back and await the next assassination.
