Reference my memorandum to you in captioned matter dated yesterday pointing out that Jay Iselin of "Newsweek" had furnished Wick information on Buchanan's visiting Deputy Attorney General Katzenbach in the Department and seeing some member of the Warren Commission. Buchanan, of course, is the man who is writing articles in the Paris newspaper, "L'Express," stating Oswald and Ruby were informants of the FBI.

DEVELOPMENT:

Jay Iselin called Wick late last evening, stating that Buchanan was to come back to Washington Thursday, 3-12-64, to see "New Republic" representatives for the purpose of writing an article in that magazine on the involvement of Oswald and Ruby with the FBI. Iselin said he did not know whether Buchanan had, in fact, returned to Washington. Iselin said it was Monday, 3-9-64, that he had talked with Buchanan. It was Tuesday, 3-10-64, said Iselin, that Buchanan had talked with Deputy Attorney General Katzenbach. During the discussion with Katzenbach, the latter arranged for Buchanan to see Howard Willens of the Warren Commission. Iselin said he believed that Mr. Katzenbach phoned Willens asking him to see Buchanan.

Iselin said that shortly thereafter, perhaps Tuesday evening, 3-10-64, or early 3-11-64, Buchanan went to New York to see his agent.

In the event Iselin obtains any more information about the activities of Buchanan in this area, he will advise Wick.
