Dear Mr. Garfinkle,

I write you because you have personal knowledge of the matters of which I write, because you have had personal involvement in some of them and because I would hope you would want to avoid unnecessary litigation the results of which I believe can be forecast with some certainty with what follows.

Several years ago I filed PA requests with the Archives and GSA. The records provided, clearly, were not complete. I appealed, to no avail.

In recent months I have obtained copies of Archives records and those of GSA that were not provided by these agencies in response to my requests and appeals.

These withheld records are important for the archive I am leaving. I want them for university deposit with all the rest of my records.

The longer compliance is delayed the more I will be required to update those requests, as I do herewith.

If you can not handle this I request that you please forward copies to those who can.

I would like to hear from you within the 10-day limit because a day or so after that I expect a visit from the professor who is in charge of this archive and I want to be able to inform him. If the agencies require more time for gathering all the pertinent records, I do not insist on compliance within 10 days. Any reasonable extension is agreed to.
