Dear Mr. Miller,

It is now over three months since I wrote to you, about a month since I responded. I hope this does not represent reversion to the period when proper work gets indefinitely delayed.

However, I will do this again. I do it for the reason I have requested. You will recall in my previous communication to you, dated 21st June 1942, I discussed these things with you. I enclose the brief notes I made to keep the various items in mind. Aside from your own notes, you will find to remind you. Because I do not want you to have possible obligations, I have not to tell you about this, but my information and knowledge of this information, when it exists, is unchanged. And quite some times has elapsed.

and have not been told in respect to my requests, also from those about which  
I have recently expressed my interest, "these the:

The autopsy notes, conveyed to the Secret Service, in part described as in Dr. Munro's hands when he testified, all of which other proofs are in my possession. These were made, did exist, and I sent you a copy of the memo with which they were forwarded and received by your agency.

The statement was obtained by Secret Service Agents from the Falkland Islands people, referred to in CDOZ. My best regards, at the archive, for these, dated November 18 of last year, i. without name R.

I find you claim that I have not received from the Archives first this  
you believe you have given them to be given to me. They have not, in fact, even  
written me that you forwarded those things. I found you claim that this manner  
of delivery is not prescribed by or required by the law and does not meet with my  
request, especially when accompanied with the now-vanished letters. It would be  
helpful if I could have copy of these.

If you feel another writing could serve a useful purpose, please let me know. As it turns out, my options are more limited than they need be or than I prefer.
