Personal attention has been given this case at St. Louis,
Missouri on December 27, 1946.

Files of the Demobilized Records Branch, St. Louis
Administration Center, AGO, World War II, revealed the subject
was inducted December 18, 1942 at Camden, New Jersey for
limited service. He was honorably discharged for the con-
venience of the Government on November 17, 1944, at which time
he held the grade of Corporal with HQ and HQ Detachment O.S.S.
He served overseas one month and 26 days, having sailed from
the United States July 11, 1943, and returned September 6,
1943. He participated in no campaigns and has not been author-
ized to receive any decorations.

The file shows no time lost under AW 107, nor any record
of courts-martial action as ever having been taken against the
subject. Character and efficiency ratings are given as ex-
cellent. Personal information confirmed his place and date of
birth as April 8, 1913 at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. He is
described as five feet eight inches tall, and his weight is
given as 220 pounds. The file indicated that he had married a
Lillian Stone August 3, 1942, and her address was given as
313 H St., N.W., Washington, D.C. His civilian occupation is
given as writer, researcher and investigator.
