

Dear Roger,

6/18/79

It was good to hear from and about you, only next time please make it a little earlier because I'm still getting up early and am trying to get a little more sleep.

Your complaint came today and I'll read it on my next rest, after more outside work, which is best medicine and psychologically very good, besides which the work has to be done.

After we spoke I remembered that I'd made some copies for you. I found them in an envelope addressed to your box. I suppose I expected to find more so I didn't mail it in the expectation. It turns out that I copied several for you or which I made no separate copies for myself.

I've gone through the separate copies I made for CES and DeBruyns filing. When L11 does more copying the balance will be copied for you and enclosed. There is <sup>other</sup> but one relevant record, really not relevant to CES, and because it is 16 pages or so I'll not copy it unless you ask. It is the transcript of the CEC interview. I do not have the CES transcript. (I have filed several appeals.)

There may well be other records that I did not make copies of. If you get any numbers in the future and I have them I'll make them for you.

I'm sure DeB kept after the FBIHQ to let him clear himself and I'm sure he knew that what Pena was saying is false. Pena had told the Schweiker committee the same thing so the FBI knew and thus DeB knew by that means if by no other. So there was a good reason for him to want to be heard on that.

Later: I've found the Rogers letter to you useful and have attached it to an appeal from an alleged inability to find any AG records in the DJ building. I cite the case only, not friendship.
