Yesterday I finished the draft of Hoax. I have that last chapter to read and correct. I hope to do that today. I then have a sort of epilogue I'm thinking of as "Caesar's Heart," in the sense of what Cassius said to Brutus. From what others have told me, probably from hearing him on their local radio or TV, he had a law firm with someone named Ferrara. He had a single Mengele client, one of his victims named Berkowitz. He said that nothing came of that because he could not file against a foreign government in the US. (Which he should have known to begin with.) He also said that in the course of that he got 25,000 pages of records. That is what led to the book and he gave Berkowitz 20% of what he got on it. I wonder what he lived on for all the time he did that work, collected that many records. And of Berkowitz financed it.

I'd like to use the results of your search for cases he filed. You said there is no record of his filing any. If you agree, I'll appreciate you putting it in correct form, what you searched, for what period, etc. And I'd like to credit you with that.

Livingstone phoned McKnight yesterday after seeing him quoted on something in the Sun. Told him that his book "is on the trucks." Asked if he knew me, McKnight said yes, and he then volunteered that he had been forced to cut some of what he said about me. Some time ago I came to believe that the libel lawyer they hired so counselled them.

He also made passing reference to saying things about Lifton.

Unless Posner lived on his wife, possible because she told Lil she is a model, I do wonder how he managed that Berkowitz business w/o money and got all those records. If I find the rest of B's name I'll send it.
