As you know, for I so told you yesterday, I think it is bad timing and potentially hurtful, including to expansion of interpretation of 5 U.S.C.552 for you to press now for what the LAPD gave Justice. I do not expect you to heed my concern, much as I wish you would and would devote this time to what I believe could be more important and more immediately productive.

However, in fairness to you, I feel I should call this, I think powerful and relevant, argument for your getting those files to your attention. I'd forgotten it until reading proofs (arbitrary number 12-2) of Frameup, the second page of the new chapter in which I discuss my FOI suit.

I there quote Clark (23):

...that the law covers all "records", whether made or received by any agency of the United States Government in pursuance of Federal law or in connection with the transaction of public business and preserved or appropriate for preservation by that agency...regardless of physical form or characteristics."

I also suggest to 'im the applicability of this language to my clothing/pic suit.
