Dear Mary,

I've just had a phone call from my friend David Saulsbury. He has made not effort to keep up with the investigation, believes it has not been closed, reports that the police have been flooded with calls and letters, and while he is not certain that the police will do anything to Harry, he is willing to give them evidence that bears on whether they should or whether they can refer it to other public authority. The latter is the reason for this letter.

All the calls and letters were to offer help in the case of Harry's lies and misrepresentations - that the police were reinvestigating the JFK assassination!

David phoned to make a date. I raise the Harry matter with him. He and his wife and boys are coming here 4/17. And he has agreed to go over with me what he can present in an effort to have something done about Harry. My own ^{own} opinion is what it has been, that is the best thing that could happen to him if it leads to the medical attention he without question needs. Although ~~this~~ ^{this} is far from my primary objective.

I am sure that when this is all over you will learn that David in fact was there only once and that Harry was not with them. I remember now that I suggested they might want to speak to Henry Wade, to use my name, and I later got a letter from Henry, who remains my friend reporting that the two of them and only the two had visited him.

^{David} He knew, by the way, that Harry and Rick had seen you but no details. I'm sorry I did not think to ask him how he knew. He was surprised that you invited them and I told him they just appeared at the door and there was nothing you or Buck were in a position to do. I guess he must have heard this internally.

I'll probably learn more when they are here and if I do I'll let you know.

Meanwhile, I hope you'll think about this. not in terms of the cop but in terms of Harry, and decide to let me have anything at all that might be of any interest to the police in ^{my} effort to get them interested in doing something about Harry.

And I think it would be best if we keep this between the four~~t~~ of us, you two and us.

I continue to wonder ^d why other than to develop more information this is an ongoing matter after all this time. I'd like to think it gives reason for hope and that I can in some way add to it.
