FERRI CONTENDED that the FBI became interested in him after he had been interviewed by Vebel. "Mr. Vebel, the man who Oswald met before he left Dallas, worked at the radio station where I served with him," he said. "Mr. Vebel and I had been good friends. Vebel was in the Missouri submarine and my submarine whatever was done to me he denied knowing."

Little is known about the investigation into the assassination. No one has ever been listed in the city directory as a psychologist. Ferrini assessed Oswald as being without any interrogator or sympathizer, especially one who could dedicate his life to killing.

IN 1961, FERRI was involved in a case connected with counterintelligence against Castro and his agents.
