Dear Maggie,

We are in the midst of moving. So many years of no physical exercise take their toll and I'm winded, so I stop for this note and to return this copy of the Letzens picture I no longer need. I should have done it a long time ago but I had forgotten about it until I blundered into it. My thanks for it. Incidentally, I am expecting to see the large prints made by the SEPost and those "big as the top of a desk" that the FBI had. If they know anything else, I'll let you know. First, however, I am going to spend what little time I can be there going over the files I'm now in. Tomorrow I'm taking some pictures of 399, other than CBS showed or LIFE took. If my intent can be captured on paper, I will have pictures that will show how the bullet is flattened at the rear end with no scratches, etc., and that there is not even at the wrong end possibility of the accountable fragments being missing. If you want prints, please let me know.

I will not go into all that I have just added in a postscript to POST MORTEM, but even after what I've published, it is, to me, shocking. It also is a pretty fat indication that the Kennedy family is not really responsible for the initial suppression of the pictures and X-rays. It is unquestionable proof that they did not keep the Commission from seeing them or using them as evidence. I want no publicity on this until the book is out, but I thought it desirable to let you and Bill know, for whatever it might mean in your own thinking.

I also have what to me is sufficient proof that Specter knew what he was doing. If he didn't know it when he did it -and I'm convinced he did -it will not long before the enormity of it struck him and, Lieboer-like, he started laying a backfire of self-justification. I will have copies of these with me when I'm out there.

There is a chance that when I pack for that trip, after all the added confusion of this hasty and already once-aborted move, with all the accumulations of two lifetimes to sort out, I may forget some things. Of those things I have mentioned having that you'd like to see, if and when you can, please drop me a reminded I can use as a check list. I must have more than 2,000 pages by now. Some of it is well scattered. I've forgotten some, and I may not think of some items.

No word from Parallax, so I do not know when I'll have copies of the New Orleans book to send, but as soon as I have them, I'll mail a package out. I hope your silence is a measure of how busy you are getting your book out!
