**Flynt Says He'll Print Names *1978***  
**of Four Involved in JFK Death**

COLUMBUS, Ohio (AP) — Hustler Magazine will identify four persons said to be involved in former President John F. Kennedy's assassination and pay informants who provided the information \$1 million, says magazine owner Larry Flynt.

One of the four persons involved in the assassination still is alive, Flynt said yesterday. He said Lee Harvey Oswald was another of the four and "was meant to be the fall guy."

"We got vital information from more than one person," he said, as a result of a \$1 million reward offer. The reward will be paid around the first of the year and will be divided among more than one person, Flynt said. He would not name the informants, but said he would when the payments are made.

The information will be published in a series in October, November and December, he said.

"It's going to surprise a lot of people," Flynt said. He said he had given the information to the FBI, CIA and House Assassinations Committee.
