LOCK SO THE THEN-CONGRESSMAN COULD TAKE THE CONFIDENTIAL FBI REPORT

HOME TO MICHIGAN FOR CHRISTMAS.

FORD HIMSELF, RESPONDING TO ALLEGATIONS THAT HE HAD LEAKED

INFORMATION FROM LEE HARVEY OSWALD'S DIAKY TO A DALLAS IFUSPAPER,

ASKED THE FBI TO INTERVIEW HIM SO HE COULD DENY THE ALLEGATIONS. HE

WAS THE ONLY COMMISSION MEMBER INTERVIEWED IN AN EXHAUSTIVE SEARCH
