

HR, JDW, JL: personal note on last words in Post Mortem appendix HW 10/5/75

There is not room for adequate handling of what these unwilling to think may believe of the final words I've added to the note that is at the very end of the appendix. With inadequate space, there is no opportunity to develop the thought. Or reasoning, or evidence, etc.

While I'm held up by Ldl taking a soak to relax, which I don't want to hurry, and so that my files may also have a record, this brief explanation.

For has no credentials to be President. He has no past justifying his selection except a past encouraging to Nixon in his moment of great trial.

This is his record on the Warren Commission. What he did and did not do there and the character of his commercialism of it. He did write of Oswald as pro-Red despite the evidence for which there is room for only a tiny part.

In time I will be putting more of this together, as I have already in what has not been published, including as JL will recall, in The Unimpeachment of Richard Nixon.

The reason for doing it here has nothing to do with making nasty cracks. It is entirely consistent with my previous writing where when I could do nothing else I did print clues for people in the future. I have always done this. In fact, this particular part can be traced to my writing completed 2/15/65, especially but not only 138 in particular, a page I have reason to remember. Because I then would not say such things.

When these kinds of pasts are exposed in detail they are also ignored by the major media. Witness WW IV.

Perhaps I'll be able to carry it further in some future work.

But if there is not this opportunity, then there will be this brief indication for someone else.

I have no doubt it is justified or I'd not have made the addition.
