A lot of people who question the official report, died suspiciously, you'll learn more about this later, but now, we thought we'd tell you about the man the Warren Commission said was the lone gunman, Lee Harvey Oswald.

It was a media frenzy, within hours we were told Oswald was a Marxist, who handed out pro-Castro leaflets in New Orleans, that he was a communist who had defected to Russia. That he had renounced America and everything American.

That he had married a Russian Woman, and that

That he had married a Russian Woman, and that he was a loner with a fascination for guns. This view of him was essential for the Warren Commission to explain his motives for assassinating the President.

To prove that Oswald was a lone gunman, they had to fit him into ah, an extremely tight schedule. So, we went back to Dallas to try to trace the fateful three quarters of an hour from Kennedy's assassination, to the murder of Officer Tippitt.

On the right, you see a clock, synchronized to the speed of the film, this is the time it actually took us. Ready, at 12:33, the Warren Commission said that Oswald left the Depository, and walked seven blocks to catch a bus, they gave him three minutes. In every case the commission failed the time test, and we had no congested traffic to deal with. But Oswald never got his chance to tell his side of the story, instead, in the most secure area, a police headquarters, he was gunned down by a man named Jack Ruby, the murderer of President Kennedy was dead, and we were told, the case was closed. Bannister connected to the FBI, Ferrie with the CIA, Oswald with contract numbers at both, all together in an office shared by Howard Hunt of the CIA. But one other person was also there, a man named Clay Shaw, the only person ever to be charged in court with the conspiracy to assassinate President Kennedy.

JAMES EARL JONES

How did you find out about Clay Shaw's connection to the CIA?

VICTOR MARCHETTI

Well, ah, in the -- at the time of the Garrison trial for Clay Shaw, I was working on the director of the CIA's staff, and he had a morning meeting everyday in which he had his twelve top lieutenants and a few staff officers, and one day he looked at the chief of the Clandestine Services and he said, are we giving ah that guy all the help we can down there in New Orleans, and he was referring to Clay Shaw and he said because we don't want that ah, words to the effect we don't want that ah crazy guy down there causing any trouble, he was referring to ah Jim Garrison and I, I thought that was kind of surprising, and after the meeting I asked the director's assistant, why he, he brought this up, I was told to be quite ah, later in the day the,

Joining us now to explain more of this history is the Chief Counsel for the Christic Institute, Daniel Sheehan. The Christic Institute is a non-profit, public, public interest law firm, best known for winning the Karen Silkwood case. Mr. Sheehan, what group made the ah, decision to assassinate Castro?

DANIEL SHEEHAN

Well, we know James that ah Richard Bissell was involved who was the Deputy Director for Plans and Covert Operations for the CIA, and we know that ah J.C. The bullet that was found on the stretcher at the hospital, the hero of the Single Bullet Scenario in its original weight was a 161 grains.

The bullet that was found weighed 158.6 grains, a loss of...

...1.5 percent of the original weight of the bullet, and yet when you look at the x-rays of these two men, you see fragments of the bullet in four anatomic locations with a significant fragment having been removed from the Governor's wrist and another piece to this day remaining in his left leg, if you put all these together, you clearly have an excess of 1.5 percent of the original weight, if you look at the bullet, Mr. Jones, you'll see this is Commission Exhibit 399, the Stretcher...

...Bullet, the Magic Bullet as the critics prefer to call it, this bullet is absolutely pristine. It's a 6.5 millimeter, fully copper jacketed, except at the base, lead core piece of military ammunition. The nose, the cone of the bullet, which allegedly destroyed four inches of the governors right fifth rib and caused a comminuted or shattered fracture of the distal radius a dense heavy bone in a man...

DR. CYRIL WECHT

... Connally, a little taller than you even that this bullet according to them, broke both those bones, and yet emerged in this pristine condition, losing only 1.5 percent of it's original weight, and that is why that one bullet could not have produced those wounds. The other reason of course is the trajectory, if you look at this trajectory, of the model...

DR. CYRIL WECHT V.O.

...that is portrayed here, you see that under the Warren Commission scenario the bullet had to have entered Kennedy's back and by the way they revised that wound, it was placed several inches higher than they did on the night of the autopsy, and then they say it went through his neck, and as it was going out to the left, and downward and forward, it would have to have stopped in midair, come back about 18 inches and then gone into John Connally's right posterior auxiliary area, which is a fancy way to say right behind the armpit, and then when it came out it saw the wrist over here and it said hey, let's get the wrist in two, it reached over, got his wrist, shot I showed you before holding the white Stetson hat and then it moved downward, now the angle through Connally's chest, was downward about twenty-five degrees the angle from the chest to the thigh was downward at forty-five degrees and yet the angle through Kennedy was upward at about seven degrees, so we've got ...

DR. CYRIL WECHT

... then a bullet which does incredible gyrations like a roller coaster at an amusement park, moving horizontally and vertically at different times depending on whatever you need of it.

JAMES EARL JONES

Thank you Doctor, we performed a test to find out if it was possible to have a bullet come out as the Warren Commission said it did, Larry Howard, the director of the JFK Assassination Information Center in Dallas, an antique gun collector and expert marksman, performed this test.

This is a 6.5 The super state of the state of floor of the Texas School Book Depository, that, and that was allegedly used by Lee Harvey Oswald. The ammunition I'm gonna fire, is the same log number allegedly used by Oswald. I got the ammunition from an antique gun collector and checked it with the information in the Warren Commission Volumes, the rifle is not a very reliable gun, many times it will misfire, now if that happened we'd have to take a second shot. The target is a combination of ballistics gel and bones, the ballistic gel assimilates the same properties of skin and Dr. Wecht suggested we use cow bones because they are very close to the consistency of human bones, here we go.

As you can see the bullet I just fired is severely distorted. Now let's compare it to C-399. Which is in near pristine condition.

JAMES EARL JONES

Dr. Wecht, let's talked about, let's talk about medical evidence, who performed the autopsy?

DR. CYRIL WECHT

This is incredible, to do an autopsy on the President of the United States, dead as a result of multiple gun shot wounds, they humund called in two Naval Pathologists from Bethesda Naval Center here in DC who had never done a gun shot wound case, who had never performed medical legal autopsies, who were not forensic pathologists, in other words a third guy called over from the Armed Force Institute of Pathology and he was in a bad situation, an army man in a naval setting and he had limited experience himself, instead of calling in top

DR. CYRIL WECHT (CONT'D.)

forensic pathologist, who had been known and utilized by the United States Government going back to World War II, and in many capacities subsequent thereto, they deliberately excluded those people because they all shared one common flaw, they were civilians, and could not be ordered to do things.

JAMES EARL JONES

Doctor, before you go on, um, let's talk with Dr. Charles Crenshaw, one of the doctors in the operating room, when Kennedy was brought into Parkland Memorial Hospital, Dr. Crenshaw has written the book JFK Conspiracy of...

... <u>Silence</u> in which he reveals many secrets he kept for over 28 years. Dr. Crenshaw the Warren Commission told us that Kennedy was shot with three bullets, all from the back, do you, did you see Evidence of anything different?

Yes, I saw definitely evidence, I saw evidence of two wounds that were came from the front, they head wound was tangential in nature, but it was a large avosteria, in the right rear part of the head, there was loss of part of the parietal temporal, and most of the occipital lobe of the right cerebral hemisphere, with exposure of the cerebellum. It was about two and a half, to two and three fourth inches in diameter, more or less circular in place and had the appearance of an exit wound. Mr. Sheehan, what can be done to stop S-Force?
