Dear John,

Your letter and check are not in accord with any of our discussions and agreements, including the one in which you had just promised to send me a check for \$239.00.

All of this came from Gambi; non from Dell, and none of it represents anything withheld from you.

You forget the violated agreement was that my costs and work on the case, which come to more than a third of the Lucas cost, were to be my part in the agreement Bair broke. So, none of this is overpayment to me and does not begin to repay my costs, aside from the value of the time Bair and Lucas both asked me to put in investigating the case for their defense, since nothing could be collected from me. On my own books, however, I am allocating this to a partial payment, as I explained to you, for the copies of my printing Dell bought and never paid for.

I am sorry you did this, very sorry, for our debt interest and taxes have come due and I borrowed money last week to pay the bank, promising to return day after tomorrow what should have come from you, following our phone conversation, before then. The balance was a check also overdue, from the National Enquirer. Both of these put me in a very bad position, aside from the worry about the unmet tax bills.

Please send me the \$100 immediately. My need is urgent. Also, when I am forced to borrow to survive, it is essential that I keep my promises on when I'll repay, or I'll not be able to borrow next time I am required to.

Aside from the fact that it is wrong, you should never unilaterally change anything you've promised to do. Others would hold it against you, very much.
