Dear John,

Here is a copy of today's letter to Pavsmar about what you have had no connection with but it may interest you. It deals with the CBS plagiarism of my work in their specials, etc.

I am due to phone Bair again soon. If there is significant development I will add it. I did reach the New Orleans lawyer yesterday and he is going to write me. There is correspondence indicating Bair was going to advance all money and divide it on the basis of what time was put in for which defendant. Now it happens that in the entire second suit I was not served, not a defendant, and if the first suit, where I have records, disproportionate time on Dell and Sega, the only ones requiring defense. For example, those few bills you got, indicate an expenditure on phone calls in the ratio of \$160 against \$6.00.

I have spoken to Marty, who can do nothing, but I did read him that very strange paragraph of Gross' letter, indicating, possibly, that he charged Sega with what I paid for and is at issue. That, if true, will be real sticky.
