When former Texas governor John, B. Connnally field I warned the Department of Justice that the bullet fragments remining in his body must be retrieved in the national interest, to avoid "vert serious embarrassment to the government" and to avoid "a new flood of conspiracy theories about" the assassination of President Kennedy during which Connally suffered five wounds in the presidents of his body, with gragments remaining in all three parts.

As I also said, if those fragments were not recovered weighed, measured and tested by neutron activation analysis, these ugly rumonrs "wouldn't be unjustified."

I was not theorizing. None of my seven published books on our political assassinations of the 1960s theorizes any conspiracy. These books, which remain the basic works in the factual writing about those crimes, espouse no theories of any kind.

The proof of the correctness of my warning to the Department is largely new and entirely official. It is in my eighth book, Never Again! the Government JFK assassination Conspiracy, now being edited for publication (Richard Gallen/Varroll and Gtaf).

The proof inludes but is in no way limited to FBI photographs it withheld from the Warren Some Commission and it provided so unclear and indistinct the colors and patterns in what JFK was wearing cannot be made out! I obtained most of this as "new" information in a dozen lawsuits against the government under the Freedo m of Information Act (FOIA). In that litigation, some precedental and the one most relevant leading to the amending of the Act in 1974 to open FBI, CIA and similar files, I got about a third of a million once-secfet official records.

That lawsuit was for the results of the seientific testing of assassination evidence.

In my FOIA lawsuit for the suppressed assassination records of the FBI's Dallas and (Civil Actions 78-0322/0420, combined)

New Orleans offices/the Department itself stated my unique credential: that I know more about the assassination of President Kennedy than anyone employed by the FBI.

Central in the contoversy over the Connally fragments as it is in the official theory of the assassination—and it should be remembered that the conclusions of the Commission

and of the FBI and the Secret Service, the two theories not being the same - is what came to known as the "magic bullet" of the Commission's single-bullet theory. AKA CE399.
