Dear Peter,

Today's Washington Post first of a three-part series has no effect on NEVER AGAIN!
Of the coming commemorations, if that is what they are, it was, on the basis of
what I knew, the only possibility of that.

One of the coauthors, George Lardner, told me that Newsweek will give it 25 pages.
I'll get and read that. But the TV stuff will be when I'm asleep and from what I've
been told are not related to what the book says.

I'll try to get transcripts of the TV shows. Posner is scheduled for some.

As we cannot say, I had some input at the Post. It did some of what I urged on it
and some of what I brought to light by FOIA lawsuits, referring to that info as "released
later." I've not asked what the next two articles will hold. They may well continue with
the "safe" formula of the worries of the earliest days.

I enclose a copy of a Baltimore Sun editorial of a month ago that indicates there
will be a receptiveness awaiting NEVER AGAIN! and that the professors who are subject
experts have adopted that thinking.

The Post did quote from that Katzenbach memo but only as reflecting the apprehensions
of y at time.
