In snother eyeal dated today I address Davis and Andrews in connection with Clay Shaw and records not provided and searches not cade.

Attached are two copies of the same record from different files reflecting ingroper and unjustified withholdings from one version that are not withhold in the other version. I regard this as more than more inconsistency, as arbitrariness and capricionsmose with the intent of objuscating and confusing in an area of some sensitivity if not potential scute embarrascent to the FM.

Sere also I want to repeat that Clay Shaw and his ITM and associates there were requalr FSI sources (I believe properly and necessarily so although I also believe that because of this the FSI feared embarrament once Shaw was charged) and that the CIA had admitted a secringly innocent relationship with Clay Show prior to the processing and providing of the attached records.

I will also provide a separate but related appeal having to do with Jesus Core, in addition to similar prior appeals.

While the file identification of the duplicate copy indicated on 4608 is too unclear for certainty some of the numbers do not appear to be those of that file.

The se-called "facts that follow the first page are not ther accerute nor complete. One is proven to be false, that Andrews was not able to use the phone. He did, several times, as the FAI knew but omits from this record. Among the incompletenesses is the fact that Cawald's consultation with Andrews also included how to get into Mexico — and Cawald appears to have used this advice. Others are that Cawald was accompanied by another person and that's some of Andrews' homostawal clients also were present.

From what Andrews told me and is not in any FAI records I've seen there was still more.

Sexual 4612 appears to be exceptional. To copies are indicated for New Orleans or the Office of Origin, Dalles. The brevity and avaidances in the LIBI cause the omission of that could be of interest that Mario Bermudes knew. And I recall no Pario Perandes records being provided by either office. But the fact of the Perandes-Shew relationship and associations were well and publicly known in New Orleans. Bermudes certainly must one the PEI should have questioned about Clay Bertrand.

Reportedly both also served on/the board of the Cordell Hall Foundation, as of the time of the CIA's foundation activities. The lawyer who told no he investigated the allocations of the foundation's fund also told me that many went to batin Americans

who could not be located.

If either of the phone numbers Andre Show provided is Show's personal phone, no listing for him appears in the 1967 directory. This would seem to indicate a close personal relationship, close caough for him to have the unlisted number.

Yet the LIM lacks even an identification of Andre Shaw, what he does, how he know Shaw, etc.

Neither is listed as a 1967 number of the ITM, also interesting.

The first contact with the El Pano Fill was the day of Shaw's arrest. It does not seem probable that andre would have made a contact the next day morely to say he was not related to Clay Shaw.

Then there is the 66 file in El Paso, separate from its assessmentation file. I have found some odd "administrative matters" in other 66 files.

In about, I believe a more diligant search is required, including in the field offices.

On November 25, 1963, Mr. Andrews informed Agents of our New Orleans. Office that he had met Lee Harvey Oswald in late June, 1963, at which time Oswald appeared at his office with several individuals who impressed him as being homosexunits. Andrews claimed that Oswald requested aubintance in waking inquirtes concerning his bad conduct discharge from the United States Marine Corps. Andrews nino indicated that Oswald asked him questions concerning the citizenship status of he and his wife.

Andrews further stated that on the evening of November 23, 1962, at which time he was in the hospital in New Orleans, under heavy sedation, he received a telephone _ call from an andividual who said his name was Clay Bertrand who asked aim if he waild be interested in handling the defense of the Harvey Oswald in Dallas, Texas, for the murder of President Kennedy.

we conducted extensive investigation concerning the data forminhed by Andrews and could find no supporting evidence that See tharvey Omwald had ever visited Andrews! office. There was no record of Opwald in Andrews' files and his secretary could not recall Oswald ever having been to the office the addition, we determined from Andrews! doctor that during the period Andrews was in the hospital he was under extreme sedation and he did not believe Andrews was capable of using a telephone on November 23, 1963. Andrews was questioned again on December 3, 1963, concerning hip affected association with Lee Marvey Oswald and Andrews stated after considering the facts in discussions with his office, staif he betteved the entire incident could have been dreamed by him in view of the physical condition he was in at the time.

We conducted extensive investigation in an effort to locate an Individual by the name of Clay Dertrand but were unable to do so. Results of our investigation were furnished to the Warren Commission and Andrews was called as a witness before the Commission. In the Warren Commissions report his testimony was noted with emphasis upon the facts tending to show the unlikelihood of his having contact with Lee Harvey Oswald. A review of the records of the Identification Divison disclose no criminal record for Clay Shaw.

On March 1, 1967, at 11:05 p.m., Andre Shaw, 417 West Yandell Street, El Paso, Texas, advised that he was a former associate of Clay Shaw, the man arrested in New Orleans, Louisiana as a possible accomplice of Lee Harvey Oswald. He stated that one Mario Bermudez, who lives in New Orleans, was a friend of Clay Shaw's and that he might know something of interest to authorities. He stated that Bermudez was connected with the Trade-Mart in New Orleans, and could possibly be reached at New Orleans telephones 523-1689 and CANAL 3591.

On March 2, 1967, Mr. Shaw advised that he was no relation of Clay Shaw.
