

New Orleans DA: 'JFK Death Solved'

NEW ORLEANS, Feb. 24 (UPI)—Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison said today he has solved the assassination of President Kennedy and will arrest every individual involved.

He was asked when arrests could be expected.

He said: "Thirty or 40 years. I am not saying that to be facetious, but we don't want to alert anyone that we are going to arrest, so there might be a repeat of what happened to David W. Ferrie."

Garrison made the statement on his way to a meeting with a group of local businessmen who said they will finance Garrison's investigation of what he terms a conspiracy hatched in New Orleans to kill the President.

Garrison revealed less than a week ago he had been investigating the conspiracy theory for three months.

He promised arrests, charges and convictions.

Two days ago, Ferrie—a man Garrison said was deeply involved in the conspiracy—was found dead in his apartment. Garrison said Ferrie killed himself and repeated his belief today.

However, the coroner reported today that Ferrie died of natural causes.
