KENNEDY DEATH PROBE IS ASKED

Club Seeks Move from Next President

The Legislation and Taxation Bureau of the Young Men's Business Club of Greater New Orleans Friday unanimously passed a resolution asking the next President of the United States to "fully determine the manner of the death of President John F. Kennedy."

The resolution asks the next President to "open and reveal and pursue all evidence" in official files relative to Kennedy's death. Discontent and suspicion of findings by the Warren Commission were cited as reasons for the resolution.

The bureau will sponsor a general membership meeting May 31 in the Blue Room of the Roosevelt Hotel at which time Louisiana Legislators will discuss "Prosperity versus Austerity: Can New Orleans Have Both?"

Newsmen covering the current legislation session have been invited to participate in a panel discussion. The meeting, open to the public, will begin at 12:10 p. m.
