

Volz Named Chief Aide To Garrison

District Atty. Jim Garrison today named attorney John Volz chief assistant DA, replacing now-judge James Alcock.

Volz, who has been an assistant DA for several years, took part in Garrison's investigation into the assassination of President Kennedy.

Alcock was named last week to replace ousted Judge Edward A. Haggerty Jr. on the Criminal District Court bench.

Garrison today also named three other attorneys to executive assistant posts in his office.

They are Andrew Sciambra, William R. Alford Jr. and Byron P. Legendre.
