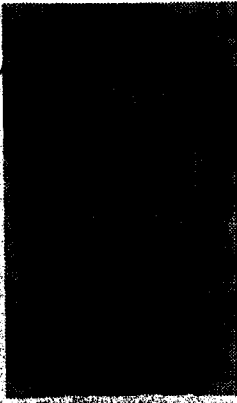

**Garrison Appeal**

NEW ORLEANS—The  
Louisiana Supreme Court  
has ordered a trial of New  
Orleans District Attorney  
Jim Garrison's claim that  
his bid for re-election was  
defeated by fraud.

The unanimous decision  
was handed down two hours  
after a hearing on argu-  
ments by lawyers for Garri-  
son and for Harry Connick,  
victor in the Dec. 15 Demo-  
cratic runoff.

The seven justices re-  
versed a Court of Appeal  
ruling which held that Gar-  
rison's challenge was not  
trialworthy because he did
