Re Memo of SUPERVISOR ERNEST C. WALL, JR., dated 12/14/67, which contained information concerning a telephone call from the ASAC of Albuquerque pertaining to proposed assassination of Orleans Parish District Attorney JIM GARRISON.

Bell, New Orleans, telephone 622-1900, advised at 2:30 PM, 12/14/67, that the Security Office for the telephone company, Albuquerque, just called and advised as follows:

At 11:15 AM, Albuquerque time, the Sheriff's Office at Albuquerque received a call from New Orleans advising that JIM GARRISON, who was staying at the Trade Winds Motel, was going to be assassinated and the calling party advised he was an FBI Agent. Stated this call was placed to Albuquerque number 505-247-3741. further advised he has the Traffic Department of Southern Bell attempting to locate the toll ticket as the call appeared to be a person-to-person call.

was advised that New Orleans was in receipt 670 of this information and that the calling party reportedly gave the name of WILLIAM C. WOODS and stated he was calling from New Orleans number 822-2414. was apprised 670 of this information and stated it would assist in the location of the ticket. Said he would call the New Orleans Office when he located the ticket.

On 12/15/67, and advised that he had located 670 the above-described toll ticket which reflects this telephone call to have been placed from the above number which is the District Attorney's Office in New Orleans, person-to-person, to Sheriff WILSON at Albuquerque. The call was made at 11:54 670 AM. Stated that he was forwarding a copy of the toll ticket to the New Orleans Office for information.
