Thanks for the clippings, which I'd not seen. The Times summary of the missile-crisis tapes is on the main point as it begins: "This is how the world didn't end." Which so many have forgotten! Like the Sy Hersh who is engaged in a denigration, The Dark Side of Camelot, now due in about a month, I'm told.

In his mis-titled Oswald and the CIA Newman states at several points that Castro was "Implicated," if I remember the word correctly, on the basis of impure myth. He was going that way. However, I ~~xxx~~ hear he is having financial problems and has had to ease off some. I never see or hear from him. Not directly.

How he could have spent 20 years in intelligence without being able to see that nobody wanted JFK to continue more than Castro I can't understand.

After all these many years I also can't understand who at least some of those in the government and with those responsibilities could not understand what they were involved in in the missile crisis and could not figure it out before it was over with the obvious.
