Just finished Never Again! after spending several weeks on it, producing about 170 pages of notes, and planning to write up a series of guide questions on it for students. Although I had read portions of it in rough draft, along with the Afterword, I must say the impact the finished product made on me was great. I was especially impressed by the cumulative effect of what you present, which makes your conclusion, epilogue, and afterword (Chap. 33 on) very powerful indeed. It is an atrocity that it is not getting the attention it deserves. In short, please accept this letter as another of the many fan letters I am sure you will receive from those who take the time to read Never Again!.

I have sent a first draft of our JFK paper up to Dennis for comments, additions, deletions, etc. As I mentioned in my last letter, he will have a few weeks to put it in final form for the conference. We will certainly welcome your comments at that point, especially if we try to get it published.

I see no change in our itinerary which I roughly sketched out in my previous letter. I should arrive in Frederick on Sat. Aug. 19th (late in the day or possibly at night). I plan to stay at least thru Monday morning, possibly into Tues. the 22nd. Dennis and his wife are still planning to come on Sun. 20th and probably stay until Tues. morning.

It was 98° in Spartanburg yesterday, but 102° in Houston --- sort of like jumping from the frying pan into the proverbial fire. We will be away about two weeks. If you were planning to send me anything, you might want to just hold on to it until I visit.
