Thanks for the interesting Luis story from the Miami Herald.

One other thing of interest is the Cuban Tower story. There has been nothing in the papers here since the indictment and the arrests. If anything appears, do not make a special mailing of it, but keep it until you do mail something. I have a continuing interest in that, but now I must concentrate on preparations for the Shea trial, and for returning to New Orleans prior to it.

Indications are the Cubans have enough money, for they have also engaged a New Orleans lawyer to conduct investigations there.

At the moment, one particular Cuban holds additional interest. He has the name of one indicted but I think is not the same guy. The name is Jose Morejon. That, apparently, is not an uncommon name. The one in whom I am particular interested has the astronomic Gonzalez, the one in the trial, Diaz. Is there a Jose Morejon Gonzalez listed in the Miami phone book? Meanwhile, if you see anything about any Jose Morejon, I'd be interested.
