The Senate Select Committee to Study Governmental Operations released on June 23, 1976 its report on its "Investigation of the Assassination of President John F. Kennedy: Performance of the Intelligence Agencies."

Since it is impossible for me to obtain enough copies of this report for all of my "national constituency" with respect to this issue, I would suggest that you contact one of your U.S. Senators from your state and request that he send you a copy, if you want this report.

This report has been turned over to the new permanent Senate Committee on Intelligence, headed by Senator Daniel Inouye (D.-Hawaii). However, I understand that Sen. Inouye has indicated that it will be at least six months before any action will be taken by that Committee in continuation of this study.

At this point, I am not certain what the future holds for my proposal, H. Res. 204, but I am determined to continue to press for a congressional investigation of the series of political assassinations which have changed the history of our country. I would appreciate your continued help and support through contact with your U.S. Representative.

Mr. Alfred Webre, a supporter of H. Res. 204, has established an organization called the Citizens Campaign for a Congressional Inquiry into Political Assassinations (CCCIPA) at 130 Greene Street, New York, N.Y. 10012 (telephone: 212-966-6030). I am enclosing a flyer which he has published.

Trumbule, Director, Sebastian Neuse, 1629 York Street, Denver, Colorado 80206, (telephone: 303-377-0578) has written to me regarding their current project to produce a 16-mm. documentary film in color of the John F. Kennedy assassimation, a 28-minute educational film utilizing a model of Dealey Plaza and the Prasidential metorcade to explain the circumstances graphically. Mr. Trumbule had asked for my mailing list, but I told him that I would prefer to tell you about his project in a letter rather than to release my mailing list.
