Subject HEMMING initiated new foreign [government level] con-1. tacts within MEXICO after 7 months of preliminary research beginning early 1971 while working in Miami, Florida area. Mexican government contact was established through cut-out during November 1971. Reference following:

Narcotics activities MEXICO-COMUS.

b. Special weapons procurement for Mexican law enforce-

ment agencies at state level.

Assessment of communist guerilla groups directed by M. ROJAS and Lucio CARAMIAS operating within the states of Guererro, Morelos, Sinaloa, Michoacan, etc.

Arranged U.S. visit by Mexican government law enforcement officials for inspection and demonstration of special wearons and law enforcement equipment at defense plant located near Atlanta, Georgia.

Evaluated reports that one or more major heroin laboratories in :EXICO is under direct control and supervision of individual holding cabinet level position in administration of President Luis ECHEVARRIA.

- Arranged for Staff Intelligence Officer, Los Angeles County Steriff's Department, to travel with small team to EEEC to copy Mexican law enforcement official files and photographs of all U.S., Mexican, and other foreign nationals involved in narcotics sauggling to Southern California areas. Team to carry photographic and portable copying equipment under both corporate proprietary and news media cover. [Staff Intelligence Official-LACSD is NT/MOUNTAIN]
- During January 1972 HERMING was contacted by FSI Agent FM/DZRY reference to assisting Miami FBI project involving QW/CZAR and QM/TURGID, which motivated a March 1972 meeting with BATF Miami supervisor HALE for backstop briefing. QM/TURGID at that time was working for operatives of the WE/SIU, Executive Office Building, Pennsylvania Avenue, Washington, D.C. and was later arrested at Watergate Building during June 1972.
- During February 1972 HFIMING formalized business relationship with PARABELLUM COPPOPATION of Miami, Florida and participated In executive protection of foreign government VIP's and special weapons demonstration for President of Congress of Deputies, and other Deputies of Republic of GUATEMALA, in Miemi, area. VIP'A were enroute to GUATEMALA from Washington, D.C. after extensive briefings at Langley and Pentagon.
- 3. During February and March 1972 while traveling within GUITEMALL, ML SALVADOR, and NICARAGUA, MINIMUM was able to penetrace a conspiracy to assassinate Chief Executive and Members of Congress, Republic of COSMA RICA and Chief Executive, Republic of PARAMA. Conspirators were notive and/or former ministers of government, Republics of GUATEMALA, EL SALVADOR, NICARAGUA, and COSTA RICA.

- During first week of March 1972 HERRING had been accepted within this group of conspirators as a decision making advisor and
 was able to thwart aims and divert much of planning toward less
 lethal ends. During March 1972 HERRING established liaison with
 QM/PAPT who introduced HERRING to QG/ZIPPER. QG/ZIPPER assessed
 as senior government and paramilitary assassin in GUATEMALA and
 EL SALVADOR. QG/ZIPPER was found to possess serious potential
 capabilities relating to terrorist employment of standard and
 special weapons, including CER systems. QG/ZIPPER is of Palestinian descent and speaks Syriac dialect of Arabic fluently on
 dealy basis.
- During May 1972 HERMING returned to Miami area. Principal leader of conspiracy was assassinated in Guatemala City shortly afterward.
- 5. Period ending December 1972 involved extensive follow-up activities relating to foreign government level contacts by HECHING with official from NECICO. Reference all republics in Central America as well as PANAWA, ECUADOR, and COLOMBIA with no foreign travel outside CONUS required.
- 6. Pariod covering 1973 requires separate summary.
- 7. During Spring 1974 FERRING was approached by U.S. and foreign nationals seeking assistance relating to their ongoing marijuana smuggling operations from COLORBIA to COMUS. Two individuals had in previous years a one time association with CIA during the CUBA project and anticipated capitalizing on this experience combined with planned involvement of long time agency assets that reside in Central and South American Republics.

 HEMING was introduced initially by DEA asset AM/STALEMATE who soon severed his relationship with subjects. HEMING was able to rapidly accomplish following:
 - a. Co-opted completely the entire COLOMBIA-CONUS planned operations of this group [QZ/PLAY:ATES].

 Traveled to Georgia for briefing with QC/NITECAP reference future operations.

c. During September 1974 traveled extensively through Central America and COLOMBIA for meetings with marijuana brokers and growers with mid level capacities of COLOMBIA-COMUS marijuana tonnage. Visited areas under cultivation and met with military commender involved in security use of landing and take off rights at joint civil-military airport designated as primary entry-departure point for aircraft utilized on smuggling route. d. Organized team of aviation-paramilitary qualified individuals with previous experience as DEA-CIA assets or law enforcement positions in Florida and Colorado areas.

e. Successfully engineered successive delays and total failure of first flight operation to COLO:BIA which caused 2 month delay of activity by Group [QZ/PLAY:ATES] which caused Group [QZ/PLAY:ATES] to terminate rela-

tionship with HEMING.

- f. Simultaneous with operations with Group QZ/PLAYMATES, HELTHIG was approached by QZ/ALKALI for assistance in locating suitable ship's captain for marijuana smuggling operations from COLOMBIA to eastern BAHAMAS. HELMHIG contacted former CIA contract employee CQ/MAPLE a licensed ship captain with agency experience in Caribbean and Congo areas, but not a DEA asset. CQ/MAPLE declined participation due to personalities maximum risk nature of the operation. No backstop available to support CQ/MAPLE.
- 8. During early 1975 EETHING ascertained that QZ/ALKALI completed operation to eastern BAFAMAS but had near fatal incident that caused death of one of his associates in area of BAFAMAS.

 HETHING continued attempts to establish contact with Group QZ/PLAYMATES with little success but did accomplish the following:
 - a. Met and identified most of QZ/ALKALI associates, buyers, and Florida distributors over a two month period. Those identified are U.S. and Colombian nationals.
 - b. Was hired as an investigator by a Jacksonville, Florida attorney whose clients filed suit against CIA alleging CIA agent [past and present] involvement in an interstate mortgage fraud [4.5 million dollars] conspiracy with undertones of cocaine smuggling.
 - c. Traveled to Washington, D.C. pursuant to investigation above and other investigations and while there on other business met with Col. Lucien CONET! of SOD-DEA at DEA HC, 1405 I Street W.W., and briefed Col. CONEIN and his assistant Tom BRIGGS reference the following:
 - Senator JACKSON investigation in Miami refer-VIETNAM business.
 - Parallel operations involving M.L. WER BELL III of Powder Springs, Georgia.
 - Private investigations group working yacht hijacking and murder on the high seas of numerous U.S. citizens.
 - 4. Penetration group anticipating future "Bounty Hunting" operations against narcotics smugglers subsidized by revenues avarded as per Titles 16 and 18, United States Code.
