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PATRICK said that he had mot CLIMT THROUTION, CORDON——MCLENDON, and MILSON-BUILT at various meetings in Dallar.
The purpose of these meetings was to raise finds for raids into Cuba. Often at these meetings, there was talk of killing KENNEDY, but he can recall no specific instance where MURE, CHISON, McLENDON, or HUNT participated in this talk.

PATRICK advised that WALLY WELCH knew about almost everything that bappened in Dallas relating to anti-communist activism during the relevant period. He did not know if WELCH would talk to one of our investigators and did not know where he could be located. He did say that WELCH married oilman TEX FELLMATS daughter.

I asked PATRICK if he knew anyone who might be able to pass for LEE HARVEY OSWALD in appearance. He said that JOHN FLOCKER, an aide to ROBERT DE FUSH in St. Louis bore a physical resemblance to OSWALD. He also said that WILEY VATES, a friend of HALL'S in Dallas, could possibly have passed.

PATRICK told me of a Los Angeles area incident regarding LEE HARVEY OSWALD in 1959 that he apparently told the office many months ago. He said that when CASTRO took over in Cuba on January 2, 1959, a group wearing 26 July Movement armbands took over the Cuban consulate in Monterrey Park. He said that Monterrey Park police investigators took photos and, among them, one showed LEE HARVEY OSWALD. PATRICK did not indicate that OSWALD was sympathetic or antagonistic to the 26 July people.

PATRICK said that on November 22, 1963, he was in Miami. When the news of the assassination flashed, he immediately thought of LORAN FROENT HALL. He had spoken with LESTER LOGUE in Dallas one week prior to the assassination and LOGUE told him (by phone) that HALL had returned. PATRICK said that LOGUE did not see HALL in Dallas after the week before the assassination.
