

JFK assassination records up calls Harold Weisberg 4/20/79  
New Orleans records - illegibility and "previously processed", improper withholdings

The first page of the attached 1/12/68 airtel from 66-10280 is close to illegible.

As in the processing of New Orleans records, this was indicated as previously processed that would amount to a withholding.

While there is no indication of the contents of the first page it is certain that at least some is reasonably segregable and that some of the withholdings is of the public domain.

There is no reason to think Oswald Hickey, I believe via, He up came in pictures taken in Dealey Plaza minutes after the assassination. Page 1 reference is totally obliterated, improperly.

The incident and Hickey's picture were all over the front pages. The unusual note is the "courtroom".

I believe Hickey was a mental case and that this also is public knowledge and was published.

The mythologists cast him in the role of a "communications man."

The mythologies are now also an important part of the historical record.

I would appreciate a legible copy of this record, without improper excisions, and proper identification so I can file it in place of the illegible version.
