Popov - (1969) uncovered by Soviet's how? By U.S. probe / Nosenko agent of Soviet Surveillance.

Brother of "Stov's partner" Stov is code for Anatoli Golitsin. He joins the game of KGB man Kovstak, who came to U.S. to activate the Soviet "reds" in 1967.

1978 - Agent "X" uncovered by Soviet CI.

1962 Oleg Penkovsky uncovered in Moscow as CIA Source.

Epstein & her - Oswald was a KGB spy - promoted in info to Stov Soviet and the U-2. Defected to her. Then sent back to the U.S. for other purposes. Epstein had her Oswald not directed to kill JK - but when he did, Moscow sent Nosenko to U.S. to provide cover for Oswald based this story credibly "Felora"

Cobb > his cooperation with Langdon Committee -
See Wise for this.

Nosenko his "legend" // CI (Staflet - Helen) believed that Nosenko was sent to deceive her from Oswald and direct attention away from Soviet "reds" with CIA

Note Epstein on Oswald's travel to Helsinki - his
credibility as a State.
