Nosenko's "lies" — But what about the nature of his interrogation > Some purpose of his interrogation

Epstein argues that Nosenko became suspicious of Angleton in early in 1962

- (1) with his Popov Story / See Brown's account of
- (2) Huxley Story / Nosenko's information to CIA.

He does not not just pop up again in 1964 after JFK assassination

Nosenko told 3 lies

(1) No recall telegram to return to Moscow, not on day he stated

(2) He was not a Lt Colonel, only a captain

(3) According to Stone, Nosenko could not have been in training of KGB he claims he was in as two of defection.

Why the CIA found itself in dilemma over Nosenko by 1967 —

Does Epstein ever mention what Nosenko reported to PAST about Russian suspicion that Oswald was a "Sleeper Agent"

Epstein discloses that Angleton's CI experts intercepted a Spontaneous anti-American letter Oswald wrote his brother in 1957 about joining Young Pioneers in Moscow

In August<sup>10</sup> 1976, CIA Director Bush, exercised a House Subcommittee for the only correspondence intercept was a July 8, 1967 letter to readers
