Reference is made to your FOIPA request on behalf of Mr. Harold Weisberg for materials concerning Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., which are contained in the FBI's House Select Committee on Assassinations (HSCA) correspondence file (FOIPA Number 245,852).

The processing of volumes 18 through 25, the June file and Sub A, has been completed and 2,278 pages are available for release. Although Title 28, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 16.10 and 16.47 authorize the FBI to charge duplication fees of ten cents per page, the 30 percent reduction granted to Mr. Weisberg for these documents adjusts the amount due to \$159.46. Upon receipt of your check or money order payable to the Federal Bureau of Investigation, releasable materials from volumes 18 through 25 will be forwarded to you.
