

Lonnie Hudkins would like me to spend a couple of years on Leon Jaworski the way I have on the JFK assassination. He said "He was the only man of whom I was really afraid. He could get you killed." Said that to his knowledge Jaworski laundered money for the CIA through the Anderson fund and through the Houston Post. (It also had a such a fund, as I recall the Hobby fund.) Lonnie says that Gerald Ford's book discloses that when Jaworski was before the Commission he said, "Alonzo H. Hudkins III? I never heard of him." That was the week after they'd lunched at the Rice Hotel. Lonnie had regular bylines in the Post and a regular column, too, in those days.
