Statements of Witnesses - Dr. Jackie Hansen HUNT (Miss or Mrs.)

Maposition - March 24, 1964, 6876-9

With Dr. Giesecke and Dr. Akin, she got an anesthesia machine to the President and helped Dr. Jenkins connect it to the endotracheal tube.

She assumed the President was dead when she first saw him, from his o eyes. Her arrival in the emergency room: About 12:45.

She didn't see any of the wounds.

She was probably in the room "no more than 4 minutes at the most." She then went to the emergency room in which Gov. Connally was being treated.

There are 3 other elevators, not quite as convenient, that can be used for stretchers between the emergency and operating rooms.

She had not previously been interviewed by any representative of the $F_{\mbox{\scriptsize e}}$ deral Government. She had no notes and made none.

Only statisticial reasons justified callfing her as a witness. She just wwelled the total number of witnesses and expanded the width of the volumes on the bookshelf.
