Much if not most is fiction.


Which may be better for you. I do not know.

I want to thank you so very much for sending the books so promptly and for autographing them. It means a great deal to me. I have been slowly going through them. I have enjoyed what I have read so far and I am sure the rest of them will be the same. There is such a tremendous amount of information that it is hard to decide what will go in my book. My husband is even reading your books and he likes the way you say things. Have you ever thought of getting them published now?

Having recently joined the JFK Forum on CompuServe, I have found a wealth of "dialogue" for my main character's boyfriend who believes in the lone nut theory. There are a lot of those on Compuserve, all supporting Posner. So it is terrific to have your whitewash truth and their "rantings"!
