## OPEN LETTER

Dear Readers,

U.S. Liberals and their "kissin' cousins," our native Communists, are beginning to be extremely worried over the current turn of national and international political events. For the first time in contemporary American history, we can categorically affirm that constructive Conservatism may well be the wave of our foreseeable future.

To those of us who delve into the workings of the Communist and Liberal mind by constantly listening to what they have to say, watching them as they perform before the nation's television cameras and reading their copious statements and literature, their cries of anguish are becoming increasingly evident. The Reds know they are in deep trouble with an overwhelming majority of the American people, and are grouping and regrouping in order to see how they can offset this new wave of, until now unforeseen, public opinion.

An ill-disguised cry of alarm was recently uttered by one of Communism's and fake Liberalism's most widely read and influential U.S. mouthpieces, nationally syndicated columnist, Joseph Kraft. The outburst typifies the deep preoccupation of the Left and serves as an example of what we are saying. Kraft, a major propagandist for Ho Chi Minh, the Communist takeover of South Vietnam, and other Marxist-Leninist objectives, was a key member of John F. Kennedy's intellectual "kitchen cabinet."

In one of his latest columns, Kraft states:

The potential for the worst, for the disaster that would be irreversible, lies with the low and middle income whites of this country - the group I have called Middle America. For this group, though its plight finds scant witness in the news media, is also under intense pressure.

Middle America, to begin with, feels more sharply the pressure to keep up with the Joneses for better cars and other appurtenances of the good life. It bears the brunt of inflation and higher taxes... and on top of all that, Middle America is being relentlessly pushed to integrate neighborhoods and schools with the black community.

These pressures make Middle America ripe for amalgamation with the ideological nay-sayers of American politics - the Birchite conservatives. And in the possibility of that

alliance lies the great danger, the irreversible disaster for this country at this time. For backed by the great mass of Middle Americans, the conservatives can come to power. And as nobody else, in a way that could not be reversed, they could plunge the country into cataclysm. Not only would they keep Negroes and Jews disaffected but they would do it against a background of increased tension abroad...

Kraft's message is a clear one. He and his ilk would be "cataclysmically" and "irreversibly" eliminated from the national scene if we, that is, Conservatism should triumph. Our victory would mean that the pseudo-Liberals, the official Communists, the pro-Red Negroes and other pro-Red entities could no longer engage in their criminal activities. The "Krafts" of our land would not be afforded the luxury of living like potentates while looking down their contemptuous noses at "Middle America," at those of us who work for our living, pay our taxes and obey our laws.

Kraft's article adds that everything must be done to "break up the alliance between Middle America and the ideological conservatives." We say that we should now do our utmost to consolidate that alliance because it is our great ray of hope. ## The "Jacquelinization" Of Coretta King

Few women in the history of the United States have been accorded the honors and acclaim heaped upon Mrs. Jacqueline Kennedy. She is portrayed by her glorifiers as being endowed with supreme beauty, unmatched gentility, unsurpassable charm, a rare facility for speaking "foreign languages," deep humanitarianism and enviable intellectual prowess. That none of this is accurately true is not considered a case in point. When the Leftists, extreme and less extreme, decide to canonize one of their useful idols, facts are of little or no consequence.

Viewed dispassionately, Mrs. Jacqueline Kennedy is nothing more nor less than a physically attractive woman almost entirely dedicated to enjoying herself and satisfying her own personal whims. Belonging, as she does, to a moneyed class, which here in the U.S. is the nearest equivalent to Europe's blue-blooded royalty, Mrs. Kennedy can afford herself the luxury of perennial vacations, so intense that each one of them is followed by "rest" periods aboard a tycoon's yacht or in a relaxing spa. She need not observe the norms of conduct shackling lesser mortals, that is, those of us who compose the "peasantry." Thus, "Jackie" has been able to engage in treks abroad accompanied by what the press billed as two prospective "suitors" while being the official guest of such an implacable enemy of the United States, and her own late husband's, as Cambodia's vitriolically anti-American Prince Sihanouk.

Mrs. Kennedy's closest circle of friends includes some of America's most notorious pro-Marxists. One of them, Truman Capote, helped finance the ac-

tivities of Castro's first and most effective "front" organization in the United States, the Fair Play For Cuba Committee, whose New Orleans "chapter" chairman, Lee Harvey Oswald, murdered Mr. Kennedy. But, Liberals give little or no importance to such trivia, and those of us who dare single them out are, no doubt, branded as unimaginative "squares" who persist in seeing a conspirator under every bed, no matter how high-born and "liberally privileged" the occupant of that bed may be.

That Mrs. Jacqueline Kennedy is the paramount goddess of the native and foreign "Liberal" establishment is a glaringly visible reality. But the Leftist camp became poignantly aware that something was amiss in these race conscious days.

After creating their great white mistress, the "Ultras" rapidly understood that it could be interpreted by our "angry blacks" as a pox on their race, culture, traditions and aspirations. Therefore, it was urgent to fabricate a black counterpart to Mrs. Jacqueline Kennedy, a black woman simply had to be Jacquelinized!

One can easily visualize the agonizing conferences held by the masterminds of U. S. Communism with their propaganda transmission belts, the ultra-Liberals, on possible and potential candidates for the Jacquelinization of a black woman. Anyone suggesting to these fellows that there were countless black American women worthy of praise and recognition would get absolutely nowhere, if with such attributes one could not also prove that the candidate possessed an unimpeachable ultra-Leftist record of accomplishments. So the choice of Coretta King as our Great Black Woman Leader was pre-ordained.

There are striking and appropriate similarities between Mrs. Kennedy and Mrs. King. Both women may be acceptably billed as worthy examples of the "beauty" of their race; both of them are openly sympathetic to the New Leftists,

and the causes so dear to Marxist's Red hearts, and both of them have undergone the trial by fire of having their respective husbands assassinated at the zenith of their political careers. It was no accident that Coretta King should have been one of the most noticeable "Very important Persons" aboard Robert Kennedy's epic funereal railroad march from New York to Arlington Cemetery.

Yet, the Jacquelinization of a personage of Coretta's stature is not accomplished without the appropriate commotion and national fanfare such a process requires. A place, a time, an occasion had to be chosen which would focus the attention of the Nation on the Jacquelinization ceremony. All of this was duly conceived and arranged, and the cast for the show was, Marxistically speaking, unimpeachable.

Mrs. Coretta King received the accolade of her worshipful admirers and subjects at a decidedly non-poor people's gala black-tie affair held in Miami's (Fla.) Bayfront Park Auditorium, on the night of August 17. Prohibited from entrance were poverty stricken blacks and Abernathy's long-suffering mule team. Again, let us underline that the "ultras" never worry over such paradoxes and inconsistencies! After all, where could the "notables" get black ties for all of America's "impoverished blacks?"

There, at Bayfront Park's affluent song and feast gathering, the dismal thoughts of "ghetto life" and marching "Poor People" were relegated to a secondary level. The setting had to be used for more important matters. To be specific, the business of offering some of the United States' most rabid Communist fronters a grandstand opportunity to exhibit their noxious ideological wares.

The instrument employed for Coretta's Jacquelinization was the National Association of Television and Radio Broadcasters composed of 500 members

plus 250 associate members, mostly black. NATRA, as the Association is usually called, was the outfit giving the banquet where Mrs. Coretta King was enthroned as "The Woman of the Year" after having been graciously awarded a Golden Mike. Other recipients of the trophy were comedian Bill Cosby and, to no one's surprise, the Xerox Corporation, seemingly for filming and distributing a nauseatingly racist and useful-to-Marxists documentary series entitled "Of Black America."

Top "entertainers" and Red luminaries at NATRA's Jacquelinization spectacular were such die-hard pro-Communists as Sidney Poitier, Castro's and Ho Chi Minh's fervent admirer, Julian Bond, and the "final speaker at the convention," Detroit's Black Power-leaning and unabashed Marxist-socialist, Congressman John Conyers, who also happens to be one of the most frequently featured darlings of the Communist Party's (USA) official press!

After the Bayfront Park get-together, proud, haughty Mrs. Coretta King indisputably occupies the enticing and rewarding position of America's "Black Jacqueline." She has earned it! Coretta can now better serve her collaborators and cohorts within the U.S.A.'s Red "fifth column."

## JUDICIAL

Superior Court of the State of California for the County of Los Angeles, No. A 233421, order re publicity.

People of the State of California, Plaintiffs vs. Sirhan Bishara Sirhan, Defendant.

The Grand Jury having returned an indictment in this matter on this date, June 7, 1968, this Court now has jurisdiction over all proceedings in this case for the first time. Therefore, the Court is now in a legal position to make certain orders respecting this matter.

Under our Constitution, each defendant is entitled to the due process of the law and a fair trial. The Court has an affirmative duty to do everything possible within its Constitutional powers and jurisdiction to make certain that each defendant does receive a fair trial.

In order to fulfill that Constitutional duty to guarantee that the defendant does receive a fair trial, and because of the obvious public interest in this matter which has produced massive news media publicity, and it further appearing to the Court that the dissemination by any means of public communication of any

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# "BLACKOUT" ON SIRHAN MAY PROTECT FUTURE ASSASSINS


*The Supreme Court of the United States and many lower courts in the land appear committed to issuing decisions which not only go against the spirit and the letter of the American Constitution, but which also serve to coddle and protect criminals at the expense of an increasingly victimized society. Nothing better illustrates this point than the utter disregard for the Constitutional guarantees of freedom of speech shown by the Superior Court of California for the County of Los Angeles. This court has issued an order establishing an almost total blackout of news and information regarding pertinent facts in the case of Sirhan Bishara Sirhan, Robert Kennedy's "alleged" assassin. As a public service, we herein reprint the order.*

out-of-court statements relating to this case may interfere with the Constitutional right of the defendant to a fair trial and disrupt the proper administration of justice, the Court, on its own motion, will now issue the following orders, a violation of which will result in swift

action to punish for contempt any offender within the jurisdiction of this Court.

It is the order of this Court that no party to this action nor any attorney connected with this case as defense counsel or as prosecutor, nor any other

attorney, nor any judicial officer or employee, nor any public official, including but not limited to any chief of police, nor any sheriff, nor any agent, deputy, or employee of any such persons, nor any grand juror, nor any witness having appeared before the Grand Jury in this matter, nor any person subpoenaed to testify at the trial of this matter, shall release or authorize the release for public dissemination of any purported extrajudicial statement of the defendant relating to this case, nor shall any such persons release or authorize the release of any documents, exhibits, or any evidence, the admissibility of which may have to be determined by the Court, nor shall any such person



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make any statement for public dissemination as to the existence or possible existence of any documents, exhibits, or any other evidence, the admissibility of which may have to be determined by the Court. Nor shall any such persons express outside of court an opinion or make any comment for public dissemination as to the weight, value, or effect of any evidence as tending to establish guilt or innocence. Nor shall any such persons make any statement outside of court as to the nature, substance, or effect of any testimony that has been given. Nor shall any such persons issue any statement as to the identity of any prospective witness, or his probable testimony, or the effect thereof. Nor shall any person make any out-of-court statement as to the nature, source, or effect of any purported evidence alleged to have been accumulated as a result of the investigation of this matter. Nor shall any such person or any witness, whether or not under subpoena, make any statement as to the content, nature, substance or effect of any testimony which may be given in any proceeding related to this matter, except that a witness may discuss any matter with any attorney of record or agent thereof.

This order does not include any of the following: 1) Factual statements of the accused person's name, age, residence, occupation and family status; 2) The circumstances of the arrest, namely, the time and place of the arrest, the identity of the arresting and investigating officers and agencies, and the length of the investigation; 3) The nature, substance, and text of the charge including a brief description of the offenses charged; 4) Quotations from, or any reference without comment to, public records of the Court in the case,

or to other records of communications heretofore disseminated to the public.

5) The scheduling and result of any stage of the judicial proceeding held in open court in an open or public session. 6) A request for assistance in obtaining evidence. 7) Any information as to any person not in custody who is sought as a possible suspect or witness, nor any statement aimed at warning the public of any possible danger as to such person not in custody. 8) A request for assistance in the obtaining of evidence or the names of possible witnesses.

Further, this order is not intended to preclude any witness from discussing any matter in connection with any of the attorneys representing the defendant or the People, or any representative of such attorneys.

It is further ordered that a copy of this order be attached to any subpoena served on any witness in this matter, and that the return of service of the subpoena shall also include the fact of service of a copy of this order. This order shall be in force until this matter shall be disposed of or until further order of the Court. Dated June 7, 1968. (Signed) Arthur L. Alarcon, Judge of the Supreme Court. *(End order)*

The immediate results of Judge Alarcon's draconian measures have been that a complete mantle of protective silence has been cast upon the Sirhan

case.

Naturally, persons who might otherwise come forth with pertinent information on the alleged slayer's conduct and motives for assassinating Senator Kennedy are no doubt afraid to open their respective mouths lest they bring upon themselves the Court's wrath.

One wonders if Sirhan's "rights" would have been so carefully guarded had he not been, as he undoubtedly is, a Castroite fanatic and a militant "New Leftist." To claim that the perpetrator of an assassination witnessed by millions of persons cannot obtain a "fair trial" because he has been "pre-judged" is a judicial absurdity acceptable only where large segments of the citizenry can no longer tell right from wrong due to long years of mental conditioning to the pernicious vagaries of fake liberalism.

About the most one can expect from Judge Alarcon's order is that it may encourage other potential assassins to seek out their victims, knowing beforehand that every imaginable effort will be made to guard them against rightful exposure and public condemnation.

Criminals may also reach the dangerous conclusion that by committing a public assassination, they will be immune to punishment on the basis of having been "pre-judged." This is what the attorney for Martin Luther King's alleged killer is now sustaining!

If the Nazis had hijacked American citizens and kept them, would we have ignored it? If the Nazis had hijacked an American ship and kept the ship and the crew, would we have tolerated this?

If the Nazis had taken over Cuba, would we have permitted this to go on?

Why? If we know that this would never have been tolerated by the Amer-

ican people then, what has come over us now, to permit and encourage the step by step degradation of the nation through our capitulation to the Communist force, when we refused to bow in prostrate awe before the Nazi horde?

## Economic News and Views

### Stock Speculation Now

If you study the economic history of any country where the flow of goods and services into and out of the free market is relatively unimpeded by government coercion, you will find that there are always periods of excessive human emotionalism which are expressed in the prices of all things we need and use. From the beginning of recorded history, mankind has tried to curtail

his normal excesses of emotionalism by government decrees. It never has worked. King Canute, the most powerful governmental lord of his day has gone down in history with his admonition to the tide "To Stand Still." People's emotionalism always runs to the extremes of optimism and pessimism. These sociological trends continue until optimism climaxes in a wave of over-speculation, which is followed by another generation's complete surprise that the ensuing deluge of losses and pessimism "can be tolerated in this advanced (?) day of human civilization, etc." Finally, after the long period of declining optimism has deteriorated into the fear that all hope is gone, a new rebirth of confidence takes place. This is what happened during the World War I post war years culminating in the 1929 Stock Market Debacle, the following depression, and which finally was regenerated into a period of economic hope in 1946 after World War II.

However, the present great advance in common stock prices did not begin again until almost complete despair had gripped millions of speculators and self-styled investors in June of 1949. In fact, the period of gestation and regurgitation continued in the stock market from 1946 until mid-1949. Just when many people thought that stocks would go to zero, and all hope was gone, our present

great eighteen-year bull market in common stocks began.

Today, our stock market has been fed another dose of the most effective psychological medicine available to keep the emotion of hope alive. The money supply in the United States has increased over \$11.1 billion dollars during the past year alone. The dollar was saved from devaluation in terms of gold only by the sleight of hand of last spring which announced a two-tier gold market and the coming of paper-gold international money. While realistic bankers throughout the non-Communist world admit that these expedients will temporarily keep the weak currencies of France, England, and the United States from ultimate devaluation, they see such sound currencies as the Holland guilder and the Swiss franc, as the only two European monies which are directly convertible into gold—and they know the German duetsche mark and the South African rand are far superior currencies for long-term holding than the U.S. dollar.

Meanwhile, realistically, the investors of Europe still like our American stocks, even though they think less of the future value of our currency. Investors and speculators here at home are also listening daily to the song of inflation—"I'd rather own less dubious stocks than more dubious money!" Meanwhile, the stock market as usual is having its minor ups and downs, and the professionals are bringing new groups and new industries out of moth balls after they have quietly achieved nice fat positions in those securities. Later on, the public will catch on and they too will buy, and so it goes. Truck loads of new paper dollars and bank credit convertible into more of those dollars, which have no metallic values of any kind behind them into which they can be converted, are the fuel that is firing the fourth and last phase of this great bull market.

The realist will have his eye on the

next elections. Some more of the same, increased money supply through greater deficits will eventually bring about over-speculation. An administration which understands this one fact of financial reality could prevent a wild over-speculation in goods and stocks, which eventually could bring about a serious depression.

Of course the Communists could wish nothing better. What a great or fantastic time they could have in this country if we ran into a period of high unemployment, declining profits, economic disillusionment, and punctured hopes. Only a sensible, knowledgeable administration and Congress which understand our vulnerability, and our financial and fiscal dangers during the coming four years, can lead us out of this present fiscal dilemma. Those who vote for more Fabian and Marxist Socialism, where by the so-called social problems of this nation are supposed to be solved by higher taxes and more deficits, plus more government intervention in the lives of those who work to produce what the government takes from them, and wastes it as well as gives it away, have the future of the entire Free World on their hands.

### BRITISH AID TO TERRORISTS

A spokesman for the Rhodesian Government has said that the section of the U.N.O.'s recent resolution urging all states to render moral and material assistance to the people of Rhodesia in their "struggle for freedom and independence" causes grave concern as it confirms earlier reports of direct British aid to terrorists as well as statements made by certain British Ministers and Members of Parliament over the past two years.

The spokesman confirmed there had been secret meetings between terrorist groups and certain British Ministers, adding that it is hoped Mr. Wilson is serious in his promise to the House of Commons to institute a full enquiry into the circumstances of British aid to terrorists.

The spokesman continued:

"It is known that many terrorist trainees have been issued with British passports; in fact, four terrorists who were training in Cyprus as recently as February 1968 were all in possession of British passports of which we have full particulars.

Some two hundred other cases of potential or actual terrorists travelling on British passports are on record.

Not only have terrorists been issued with British passports. Expatriate leaders of revolutionary groups have been equipped with such documents, men who have been engaged on clandestine arms and ammunition acquisitions from Europe, including Iron Curtain countries.

Cases are on record of Rhodesian nationalist leaders negotiating from London with arms suppliers and one particular case concerns sample weapons, including machine guns, and ammunition actually being brought into Britain from the Continent.

A number of Rhodesian, South African and Portuguese so-called students now in Communist countries travelled

via Lusaka, Dar-es-Salaam and Nairobi to London, Frankfurt, Rome and Cairo with travel documents issued in Zambia not only by the British High Commission there but also on letters of identification issued by the African Nationalist Offices in Lusaka.

In the past it appears that such illegal and unrecognized travel documents have been accepted as an authority to issue a

British passport not only in Dar-es-Salaam and Nairobi, but also in London."

The spokesman concluded:

"If Mr. Wilson is really serious in his promised enquiry, the Rhodesian Government hopes he will make the right approach to us for information on this subject which may become an internal security threat to Britain as well as Rhodesia."

### Wilson Won't Destroy Rhodesia

Mr. Harold Wilson has as much hope of destroying Rhodesia through mandatory sanctions as America has of smashing South Africa's gold market: and that is, none.

That's the prediction of one of the Republic's top economists and planners, Dr. Dawie Marais, writes Aida Parker in *The Sunday Tribune*.

The Marais predictions have shown a re-assuring pattern of proving correct. Almost alone even among South African economists, he predicted within hours of UDI in November, 1965, that the Rhodesians would survive: this at a time when the rest of the world confidently believed that Mr. Ian Smith and his men would topple within three months.

Commenting on the steadily-accelerating efforts to achieve a total trade blockade around Rhodesia, Dr. Marais, speaking to me from his home in Pretoria, said: "Mr. Wilson has clearly come to the point where he cannot tolerate the continuation of his failure.

"The Security Council resolution was certainly a last-ditch attempt to bring down the Smith Government. It is equal-

ly certain that it will not succeed.

"Every time action has been taken against Rhodesia, the impression has been created that this is it: that this is the time they are going to kill the cat.

"In the meantime, everyone knows that a roaring international trade is being done, and will continue to be done, with Rhodesia. It will happen again this time. The forces of international trade are simply too strong for embargoes and boycotts of this type to succeed.

"It is the same with America and our gold. America is trying to force our hand. They are more determined than ever to get rid of gold. They are trying to create the impression that it is utterly valueless, even for wedding rings.

"Yet the fact remains that the demand for gold continues at a very high rate indeed. It is also becoming abundantly evident that the two-tier price system simply will not work. Both Mr. Wilson and the Americans have completely overlooked the realities of international finance—and the universal acceptance of gold."

## REBELLION IN RED CHINA

Shanghai's *Wen Hui Pao* has conceded that mounting subversive activities are being carried out by anti-Mao groups in cities and other areas.

In a recent editorial, the Communist daily strongly appealed for cooperation of the masses to suppress anti-Mao elements plotting against supporters of the Party chairman.

It bitterly charged that a handful of anti-Maoists are carrying out subversive plots in an attempt to restore their power against the Mao regime.

"In some provinces, they (anti-Maoists) have been destroying railroads, looting national properties and attacking military establishments and greatly disturbing production," the editorial said.

*Wen Hui Pao*, one of Red China's five major newspapers, went on to say that those who attempt to destroy "proletarian dictatorship, newly organized revolutionary committees and the cultural revolution" must be punished mercilessly

### MASS JAILBREAK

10,000 political prisoners, after escaping in Red China near the Hongkong border in early June, killed scores of policemen, soldiers, Red Guards, and government functionaries in Canton.

"At least 10,000 political prisoners, who were serving sentences of 18 years upward, escaped from the Cheungmuktau labor reform camp after killing all guards at the camp," reports from Hongkong said.

"They stormed into Canton, killed all the personnel at the Canton public security (police) bureau and burned the bu-

reau offices down," the reports said. "By then they were equipped with weapons and automobiles seized at the labor reform camp and the security bureau."

"They killed large numbers of soldiers, Red Guards and Communist cadres in Canton. Then they were split into three groups, aiming to escape to Hongkong and Macao."

One of the groups planned to come to Hongkong by way of Po On county, and the other two to Macao by way of Shihchi and Chiangmen counties, according to the Chinese-language paper.

"But several thousand of them—the group which was going to Macao by way of Shihchi—were killed in an ambush by the People's Liberation Army. The army troops arrived after the prisoners had stormed into Shihchi and killed many public security men and Red Guards."

The reports said the whereabouts of the other two groups were unknown. Nor did they give the exact date of the jailbreak.

### CHAOS MOVES NORTHWARD

The anti-Mao rebellion that has caused chaos and numerous deaths in the southern border provinces is moving north. Newspapers in Kweichow and Hunan provinces have warned that "the state is in danger of being wiped out."

Kweichow and Hunan are to the northeast of Kwangsi and Kwangtung provinces, where anti-Maoist disorders have been going on for the last two months.

Editorials in the *New Kweichow Daily* and *Honan Daily* confirmed what travelers have said in fragmentary reports.

The *New Kweichow Daily* said supporters of Liu Shao-chi "are committing every kind of inexcusable crime to sabotage and overthrow the social "order" of Chinese Communist chairman Mao Tse-tung.

It accused "agents of China's Khrushchev"—the Maoist name for Kiu—of "inciting and leading the masses into killing

people, starting fires, sabotaging production and communications, sowing discord, splitting the people from the army and creating violent civil war."

#### RED GUARDS ARRESTED

Thousands of Red Guards in Canton have been arrested by People's Liberation Army troops, who have orders to shoot to kill, according to newspapers in Hongkong.

The *Sing Tao Jih Pao* reported that 300 persons had been killed and another 200 wounded in an armed clash between rival Red Guards at Chiangmen county, east of Canton.

The paper said that in Canton the military control commission had arrested several thousand Red Guards.

"The military control commission will stage a public trial in the near future at which several Red Guard leaders will be sentenced to death to serve as a warning to other Red Guards, the *Sing Tao Pao* said.

The Canton garrison was under orders from Peiping to maintain law and order. Since last July 15, the soldiers had been authorized to shoot to kill Red Guards, it reported.

"The soldiers took this as their chance for revenge," it added. "There were reports of soldiers being murdered by Red Guards and raids on arm depots."

In another report, the *Kung Sheung Daily News* said, that "large groups of troops barricaded the streets in Canton in an operation to arrest Red Guards who had defied orders to return to their towns or behave themselves."

"Red Guards are now termed the blacksheep of society," the daily said.

Both the *Kung Sheung Daily News* and the *Hongkong Times* said a similar operation to suppress Red Guards had been launched in Peiping.

But the Red Guards in turn had launched an armed confrontation against the local military control commissions, the *Times* said.

More than 300 persons were killed and another 200 persons wounded in a clash between the East Wind Red Guards and the Red Flag Red Guards at Chiangmen" the *Hongkong Times* added.

## Dr. Ku Suggests Second Front To End Vietnam Conflict

Dr. Cheng-kang, President of the China Chapter of the World Anti-Communist League, has urged the opening of a second front on the periphery of Red China and offensive strategy in Vietnam to end the Vietnam war.

He made the statement when asked to comment on the statement of U.S. Congressman John H. Buchanan Jr, who suggested that Washington ask the Republic of China for the dispatch of 100,000 troops to help turn the tide of war in South Vietnam.

Ku said the statement of the U.S. law-maker indicated that American friends and parliamentarians have come to recognize "the key to the solution of

The *Times* said the clash was stopped by the military control commission before it got out of hand.

#### TROUBLE IN CHEKIANG

Factional fighting, described as "most serious," was reported to have taken place among Communist organizations in the province of Chekiang with "sympathizers" and "agents" of the government in Taipei being accused of responsibility for the strife.

Radio Chekiang said that the southern part of province was the scene of some "serious fighting between chairman Mao's supporters and their opponents."

The broadcast and an editorial in the leading provincial newspaper, the *Chekiang Daily*, called for "resolute suppression" of the trouble-making elements.

"These renegades, spies, capitalist roaders, incorrigible bad elements and remnants of the Kuomintang are trying their dirty tricks, using all measures to carry out their sabotage," the broadcast said.

Asian problems." But he declined to comment on the military aspect of the suggestion saying that it is a military problem which is outside his sphere.

On the past of the Republic of China, the APACL chairman said, it should play a full part in stepping up the political and military cooperation of the member nations in the Asian Pacific Council. Such cooperation is necessary to supplement the cultural and economic cooperation of these nations in safeguarding the security of free Asia.

The day has now come, Ku pointed out, for the free world to mobilize the power of Asia to protect the safety of free Asian nations.

Speaking on the Vietnam war, he contended that offensive operations must be taken to wrest the military initiative from the enemy. From a military stand point, he strongly urged the opening of a second front on the periphery of Red China and a major landing in North Vietnam to end the conflict.

The leading anti-Communist civilian leader also suggested that the Saigon Government should continue to improve the living standards of the Vietnamese people through economic development and other effective measures. In doing so, he pointed out, the Vietnamese people would show greater enthusiasm for the war against the Viet Cong.

## *No Parallel Between Soviet-Czech And U.S. Actions In*

In their apparently desperate efforts to consolidate their entrenched positions of affluence and political power within the Liberal establishment, John Kenneth Galbraith, Eugene McCarthy and George McGovern have stooped to peddling bare-faced lies to the American people.

The most cruel example of how these men, and others who emulate them, can sit down and over the facilities of national television calmly address themselves to millions of persons, distorting the truth beyond recognition in order to aid the strategy of the Soviet Union, was afforded by the statements Galbraith, McCarthy and McGovern made over NBC the day after the Soviet Union invaded Czechoslovakia.

As though they had been in previous accord, Galbraith, McCarthy and McGovern minimized the Kremlin's ruthless invasion and occupation of Czechoslovakia by setting forth completely false parallels between the Czechoslovakian tragedy and American action in Cuba, the Dominican Republic and Vietnam. They voiced the sentiments and treasonable feelings of the entire fake Liberal community in the United States. These three individuals, who are currently the top spokesmen for American ultra-Liberalism, persistently managed to twist around facts and alter the truth, in order to maintain their ideological alignment with whatever is beneficial to the international objectives pursued by the Soviet Imperialism. For them, in any confrontation between the United States and aggressive, Communist expansionism and imperialism, the Reds are right and we are invariably wrong. Their ideological stock in trade seems to be to give aid and comfort to the enemy.

On the night of August 21, Galbraith, McCarthy and McGovern told the American people that we were all partially guilty of the Soviet invasion of Czechoslovakia "because of Vietnam" and

"U.S. interventions in Cuba and in Santo Domingo." They clearly implied that the United States set the example for what the Red Russian imperialists were doing to the hapless Czech people.

There is no comparison, parallel or analogy between the Soviet Union's actions in Czechoslovakia and the American position in Vietnam, Cuba and Santo Domingo.

The United States went to the assistance of the South Vietnamese people

when the legitimate and internationally recognized government of South Vietnam officially asked for American support. The United States did not go into Vietnam, occupy all of its territory, arrest its President and Prime Minister and set up a coerced regime against the will of all of the South Vietnamese people. This is what Russia has done in Czechoslovakia. Furthermore, no high-ranking South Vietnamese official has gone to the United Nations, or anywhere else, to

# DID DUBCEK BETRAY CZECH FREEDOM

*(The following article was written shortly before the Soviet Union and its minion allies invaded Czechoslovakia on August 20. It serves as a historical reference on how Alexander Dubcek apparently deceived his people in behalf of the ruthless Kremlin imperialists.)*

## AT BRATISLAVA?

— BY J. JOSTEN —

(London/FCI) Would anyone think it possible for a man to become a star performer in a striptease? Or that Alexander Dubcek of Czechoslovakia, who gained such a great support from his nation in his challenge of the Soviet armored threat and political blackmail could voluntarily become a signatory to the treacherous communique of the five Stalinist powers in Bratislava?

I for one consider it to be a most intimidating and reactionary document, which, in its wider aspects, had equalled the threatening letter which came as a result of the Warsaw meeting of the Soviets and her satellites, the East Germans, the Poles, the Hungarians and the Bulgarians.

For those who saw Mr. Dubcek win his nation's sympathy for his attempt to withdraw from the spiderweb of Soviet intrigue, both bi-lateral and through the Warsaw Pact and the Council of Mutual Economic Assistance (Comecon), his alleged approval of the "further pooling of efforts of Socialist States" is a step backwards. For someone who claims to speak for the whole nation, Communists and non-Communists alike — and there are admitted to be eighty per cent of the latter — a pledge "to educate popular masses in unbending loyalty to Marxism-Leninism" and a promise of "irreconcilable struggle against bourgeois ideology, against all other anti-Communist (understand non-Communist) forces," "with mutual help and support" from the other still Stalinist signatories, is only opening the doors to renewed foreign interference in internal matters.

As the leader of a country bled white by Soviet-ordered interventionist armament and other costly deliveries to countries like Vietnam, Egypt and Syria, not to speak of Cuba and a dozen African and South American territories torment-

ed by guerrilla warfare, Mr. Dubcek saw his possible salvation by ending such tragic commitments. Yet now he has signed a document stating an "unbending determination to continue to support the heroic Vietnamese people, to render them necessary assistance in their struggle against American invaders," the same Americans who were at one point inclined to release for him 20 million dollars of gold looted by the Nazis from

tinues tense as a result of the aggressive policy of Israel's ruling circles."

For those who have not forgotten what the map of Europe looked like before the last world war and who know the true boundaries of the Soviet Union, there is little doubt why the Soviet occupiers of Eastern Poland, of Rumania's Bessarabia, of Czechoslovakia's subcarpathian Ruthenia, of Finland's eastern borderlands and, last but not least, of the three once independent states of Estonia, Lithuania and Latvia, forced Alexander Dubcek into a promise "to rebuff any attempts to revise the results of World War II and to break the frontiers that have taken shape in Europe." This smacks of an Eastern Munich.

To add insult to injury, to play on the pathetically short memory of the bourgeois capitalist politicians and press, the "principles of the Bucharest Declaration and of the statement of the Karlovy Vary conference of European Communist and Workers Parties" proclaimed and introduced with the cooperation of criminals like Novotny and Ulbricht are thrown into the Bratislava gift parcel in one brief sentence. Has a single commentator abroad bothered to look up the details of these acts of conspiracy and subversion?

In short, under the claptrap of nauseating Bolshevik phraseology and outworn cliches lies buried a rope with which Brezhnev, Kosygin, Ulbricht, Gomulka and associates can hang Dubcek and all his country's newly won freedoms the moment they wish to proclaim his deviation from the impossible pledges they made him sign. And all this is happening with the acclaim and jubilation of many who feel they have won a respite for their own electioneering or for more profit in trading with the Soviet vultures.

*Nothing better proves that the Communist Party, USA (CPUSA) is nothing more than a conscious agent of the Soviet Union operating inside of the United States than the rapidity with which it echoed the Kremlin's position on the Russian invasion of Czechoslovakia. Almost at the same moment the Soviet tanks and troops of its puppet allies were rumbling across Czech borders, Gus Hall, General Secretary of the Communist Party, USA, issued a statement which was a carbon copy of the one made by the Kremlin to justify its action against the Czech people.*

We do not yet have all the facts necessary to make clear whether or not there was any other alternative to the action taken. However, from the vantage point of a party existing within the world center of imperialism, it seems to us the most fatal error would be to underestimate the subversive powers of im-

perialism or the dangers of an anti-socialist takeover in Czechoslovakia for the entire socialist world.

We are for the defense of socialism. We are for the development of a democratic structure that is in keeping with the advancement of socialism. We are for freedom. But we are not for the freedom of those who endanger socialism.

Imperialism never gives up its struggle for domination. Wherever it is not prepared for immediate military confrontation, it works by every means at its command, to infiltrate, to undermine and to soften up those countries that are the objects of its attack, in order to lay the groundwork for military intervention, at a later date.

These are some of the fundamental premises on which we must judge these and all events.

## HOW FABIAN SOCIALISTS ARE RULING CANADA

The Fabian Socialist Society took the name of Fabian from the policy of temporizing it adopted, claiming to imitate that of the Roman general and dictator Fabius Cunctator, during his fight against Hannibal, whom he eventually defeated. In the modern political context it implies a tactic of delay, infiltration, penetration and takeover from within.

George Bernard Shaw, who played such a dominant role in the Fabian society for nearly half a century, frankly described its policy of permeation in these terms: "Our propaganda is one of permeating — we urged our members to join the Liberal and Radical Associations in their district, or if they preferred it, the Conservative Associations — we permeated the party organizations and pulled all the strings we could lay our hands on with the utmost adroitness and energy, and we succeeded so well that in 1888 we gained all the solid advantage of a Progressive majority full of ideas that would never have come into their heads had not the Fabians put them there." — The Fabian Socialist Contribution to the Communist Advance, by Eric D. Butler.

Now do you begin to understand what Messrs. Trudeau, Pelletier and Marchand have been doing in the Liberal Party this past while. After all, Mr. Trudeau made their position clear when the NDP charged in 1965 that their former socialist colleagues — Marchand, Pelletier and Trudeau — were deserting them to join the Liberal Party. In an explanatory article in *Le Devoir*, Messrs. Trudeau and Pelletier wrote that "we are pursuing the same objectives and adhering to the same political ideas we have been espousing

for so long in *Cite Libre* . . ." These ideas included "a politics open to the left." Messrs. Trudeau and Pelletier frankly stated in their article of explanation that "a political party is not an end, but a

means."

But let's give these Quebec Fabians credit. After all, they not only used the Liberal Party; they took it over lock, stock and barrel.

### The Ultra-Liberal Canadians' Darling: TRUDEAU

Canada's new Prime Minister, Pierre Trudeau, is receiving the plaudits of the American "Liberal" press. Until now, very little was said in most of our news-media about Canada's chief executives. No doubt they were considered to be too colorless for extensive coverage and comment. But matters have changed. Our gigantic northern neighbor has a Prime Minister with extremely definite coloration, and his political tones can be pictured as going from glaring pink to an alarming crimson. Naturally, this explains why at least one nationally circulated magazine has enthroned Trudeau as a "cover picture" attraction, and why he is being hailed as a combination of a female-conquering glamor boy and a political wizard. Yet, for Conservative "squares," Prime Minister Trudeau's background is shocking.

Here are a few highlights of his past antics and political activities:

1940: He was expelled from the Canadian Officer Training Corps during the war for lack of discipline.

1950: He was in Shanghai when the Communists took over, and became a rabid admirer of Mao Tse-tung and his homicidal Red regime.

1951: Back in Montreal, he launched

the Leftist "Cite Libre," collaborating with well-known Reds like Professor Raymond Boyer (convicted of espionage in the Gouzenko case), and Stanley Ryerson, leading Communist theoretician and editor of the *Marxist Review*.

1952: He led a delegation of Communists to the Moscow Economic Conference.


1953: He was forbidden admission to the United States as "an inadmissible person."

1960: He led a delegation of Communists to Peking for Red victory celebrations.

1961: To prove his fanatical admiration for Cuba's Fidel Castro, Trudeau attempted to paddle from Canada to Cuba in a canoe, but was intercepted by the U.S. Coast Guard and deported back to Canada.

True to form, Prime Minister Trudeau is currently demanding diplomatic recognition of Communist China and is more than sympathetic to North Vietnam's Ho Chi Minh.

With a background such as this one, isn't it logical that the U.S. "Liberal" press should sing praises in honor of Canada's latest Prime Minister?



Perhaps never before since the days of Martin Luther have there existed such deep dissension and out-and-out defiance to Papal authority and infallibility as is now running amuck within Latin America's huge Roman Catholic communities.

The core of the struggle afflicting Catholicism is basically the same as the confrontation which has kept the world in turmoil since the Bolsheviks took power in Russia half a century ago. It is, in essence, a struggle between militant Marxist elements posing as "progressive Liberals" and the Conservative pillars of the Church who are fully aware of what is going on.

The Liberal prelates claim that the Church in Latin America has always sided with the "oligarchies" and the "power structure" and that this must not only cease, but that the Roman Catholic Church must be at the vanguard of revolutionary movements to alter the status quo in order to benefit the proletariat.

The Conservative elements among the Catholic hierarchy claim that the mission of the Church is not to engage in basically political activity but to establish and maintain guidelines for matters directly related to man's soul and spirit, while upholding the traditional tenets of the Christian faith.

The "Liberal" clergymen sustain that filling "empty stomachs" and fighting "poverty" is more important than worrying over man's eternal salvation. The one, tell-tale flaw in their strident approach to "oligarchical oppression," want and poverty is that, with few exceptions, the ultra-Liberals consistently refrain from denouncing or attacking the hunger and tyranny which is endemic in Communist-ruled lands. Worse yet, these heretical elements within Roman Cath-

olicism, ranging from cardinals to parish priests, like their counterparts in the Protestant American National Council of Churches, not only are not at all loath to work hand in hand with atheistic Marxist-Leninists, but eagerly join forces with Latin America's most notorious pro-Moscow, pro-Peking or pro-Castro Reds.

As a prelude to Pope Paul VI's visit to Bogota, the pro-Red clergy indulged in incredible and outrageous acts of lawlessness.

One of the most scandalous episodes occurring in Latin America was the recent sit-in carried out in the Metropolitan Cathedral of Santiago de Chile by priests, nuns and an assortment of identifiable pro-Communists. The clergymen and their allies barricaded themselves inside the Cathedral protesting "social conditions" in Chile and had to be forcibly ousted from the temple. Ironically, Chile today is ruled by a "Christian Democrat" Administration headed by one of Latin America's most ultra-Liberal and "left of center" rulers, President Eduardo Frei. President Frei has done his utmost to maintain friendly relations with Fidel Castro and the entire national and international Communist menagerie, but there is an old Spanish saying which states, "Badly does the Devil pay those who best serve him," and this is proving correct, not only for Chile's Chief Executive, but for persons and organizations everywhere senselessly attempting to "play ball" with the Reds and their pawns.

The immediate result of the Metropolitan Cathedral incident has been that sizable groups of Chilean Roman Catholic priests and nuns have formed what they have called the "New Church." Apparently, the ultimate objective of the "New Church" is to destroy the authority of the Pope. Once this has been accomplished, the fragments of Roman Catholicism will follow the course of subservience to Communist dictates practiced by Russia's Orthodox Church and the "New Churches" which act as appendages of Eastern Europe's Communist regimes.

The current "Patron Saint" of Chile's "New Church," and similar dissident

groups in and outside of Latin America, is Camilo Torres, a fanatically Castroite Colombian priest who was killed by his country's Armed Forces while he was fighting as a member of a Castroite guerrilla band operating in Colombia which, by the way, also is governed by a freely elected and extremely Liberal President and Administration.

The truth is that Pope Paul VI has no one to blame but himself for the chaos and anarchy threatening his rule and the Roman Catholic Church. Following in the footsteps of his Leftist predecessor, Pope John XXIII, Pope Paul has been eagerly trying to "peacefully co-exist" with Communists and Communism. His censurable, appeasing attitude toward the Kremlin gang not only has greatly strengthened Italy's Communist Party, but also has encouraged the rapid growth of Red heresy all over the global expanses of Roman Catholic control and influence. In instance after instance, Communist leaders have been signaled out for Papal honors and distinction. Even Cuba's ridiculous puppet "President,"

Osvaldo Dorticos, is the recipient of a Papal medal, and the Pope's personal representative to the Castro Regime, Monseigneur Zacchi, has so vociferously taken it upon himself to extol Fidel Castro's extremely dubious "virtues" that he has brought upon himself the condemnation of some of America's most distinguished Roman Catholic leaders.

The most dangerous threat to Papal

infallibility is the pro-Red clergymen's current rebellion against the Pope's ban on the use of "the pill."

The Red heretics, following classical Communist techniques, have chosen an issue which will enroll in their ranks many politically naive female sympathizers completely unaware of how they will be used to tear down their own Church. The Reds know that "the pill" issue and their promotion of artificial birth control will endear them to countless confused feminine hearts. "The pill" and its uses have become the cornerstone of the anti-Papal rebellion spearheaded by the leaders of the "New Church." The matter has become so alarming that His Excellency, Monseigneur Romolo Carboni, Papal Nuncio for Peru and Titular Archbishop of Sidon, has categorically stated: "He who does not obey the words of the Pope is not with Christ's Church."

Solemnly addressing the members of the Roman Catholic Church in the Republic of Peru, Papal Nuncio Carboni carefully explained the reasons why Pope Paul VI issued his encyclical "Hu-

manae Vitae" which forbids the use of pills or any other unnatural means to avoid pregnancy. Stated the Nuncio: "Yes, it is a natural law, which is the law of God, that imposes strict norms of conduct upon those in wedlock; a Christian and human control and an equally human and Christian discipline. These are virtues worthy of the Children of God and the Brothers of Christ; real and authentic sacrifices which also produce adequate enjoyment and prizes so great that they never cease as they begin on Earth and continue for all eternity. . . .

"Sterilization, abortion and all means and methods of contraception, mechanical and chemical, are openly and clearly condemned by the Papal Encyclical for they conspire against life, favor death and serve as instruments of disdain, exploitation, humiliation and the greatest ruin, even worse, the moral and, very frequently, the physical death of women."

Monseigneur Carboni also emphasized that married couples may practice birth control only through complete abstinence during periods of female fertility, of "conjugal union" during periods of female infertility. Stated in simpler terms, the Nuncio has said that the Pope's encyclical ratifies the use of rhythm birth control as the only acceptable manner which may be used by married couples to avoid procreation.

The Roman Catholic Church's severe rules on birth control are traditional. Pope Paul VI's encyclical simply ratifies this position, but the Red heretics and their followers were anxiously waiting for an issue which could be employed to inflame passions and aid in their self-appointed task of tearing down traditional institutions and respect for authority. They have found it: "The pill" will now be exploited by Reds to aid in the destruction of the Roman Catholic Church, just as "poverty" is being wielded, with other issues, to foment bloodshed and rebellion in the Americas and elsewhere. In each instance, the Communists and their disciples discover a pretext or an excuse to spread their tyrannical and atheistic dogmas. Perhaps now, at long last, Pope Paul and so many other leaders who try to appease and coddle the perfidious Communist enemy will discover their foily and cleanse themselves of this stigma.

As far as rank and file Roman Catholics are concerned, the choice agonizingly boils down to the Pope or "the pill," for if they decide to disregard one encyclical, in this case "Humanae Vitae," there is no logical reason why they should obey any of them, and this will forever shatter the principle of Papal authority and the millenary edifice of the Roman Catholic faith and Church.

**NO PARALLEL . . . . .** (Continuation) other hand, the Soviet Union gave Fidel Castro some of its most powerful and sophisticated weaponry and armor to face the invading Cuban patriots.

If the United States had done in Cuba what the U.S.S.R. has done in Czechoslovakia, it would have had to land in force on Cuban soil, assisted by the troops and tanks of several Latin American countries and, after proceeding to the total occupation of the Island, seize Castro and the leaders of his regime, doing to them what the "Warsaw Pact" nations, headed by the Soviets, have done to Dubcek and other top-Czech leaders.


Even under these circumstances there cannot be parallel between the results of an American intervention and a Russian-led Communist enslavement of peoples.

A U.S. involvement implies the bolstering of freedom and dignity for the peoples it affects. A Soviet "intervention" is exactly the contrary; it signifies the consolidation of tyranny and cruel oppression in the communities brought under heel by the Reds.

To equate the American system of government with Communist rule, as the ultra-Liberals so repeatedly do, reeks of treason and this is exactly the idea and the image Galbraith, McCarthy, McGovern and other members of the Fulbright-inspired crowd are attempting to convey to the American people and the world.

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# FLORIDA SUPPLEMENT

## UNITY BY DIVISION

The Republican Party in Florida had fallen into such a moribund state eight years ago that it had to be divided before it could be united.

Governor Claude Kirk seems to be the only Republican who is out of step with the State GOP now singing a song of unity from the panhandle to the Keys.

In essence, this paraphrases Dade Republican leader Paul J. O'Neill's view of his Party as it means another important election in November—one which will serve as a barometer of the progress toward a viable two-party system in the State.

Relaxing in his office for the first time since the tumultuous National Republican Convention in nearby Miami Beach, O'Neill could afford to be magnanimous to his former Republican boss.

• Though Kirk had broken with State leaders to support Rockefeller, he had, after all, been responsible for bringing the Convention to Miami Beach in the face of very large obstacles, O'Neill observed.

Kirk's main problem, as O'Neill sees it, is to confront his over-developed ego, grasp it and control it.

O'Neill's confidence is also boosted by the fact that the GOP would field more candidates than ever in November.

"We're going to have representative candidates run for more offices than we've ever had in history," he said.

With Ed Gurney, Mike Thompson and Shelby Highsmith—to mention a few—O'Neill pointed out that the GOP was in a good position to elect a State

senator, a U.S. representative in the most populous county, and a state attorney in Dade County (Miami).

While things are looking up for the Grand Old Party, they weren't always that rosy.

Nearly a decade ago, the Party was in the hands of a few men who used it for their own personal aggrandizement, O'Neill charges.

That is when he and his wife, Alyse, State Committeewoman, took a serious interest in the Party's politics.

O'Neill, a World War II Navy officer who had been conducting anti-Communist study sessions in the Miami area, decided with Alyse that the best way to combat Communism was through active participation in politics.

But he soon learned, he said, that the then Party leaders were strangely motivated.

"They made certain," he said, "that they didn't get good candidates, and if they did, they worked against them. "I call them the destructive type of Republican."

It was as if the Party had been infiltrated by Democrats.

His own primary effort against Bob Peterson in the early 60s was unsuccessful, and in 1964 he ran against a tough veteran opponent in a Liberal-dominated area, Claude Pepper.

Although Alyse was once a Democrat, back in Philadelphia, O'Neill has voted Republican from his first election in his native New Jersey, though he emphasizes he has always voted for the best man of either Party.

The fight to rid the Party of dea wood did not succeed until 1966, when the Party leadership throughout the State changed hands.

Digressing for a moment, O'Neill turned to other forces which have divided the GOP.

Former Washington Senator, Harry P. Cain, has been completely repudiated by the State and local Republican Party, he said, though he continues to be widely sought by the news media as a "spokesman" for the "Republicans."

"I just figure that he ought to register as a Democrat," O'Neill said wryly. Cain and Dan Paul, a registered Democrat, supported the candidacy of Gov. Nelson Rockefeller."

He doesn't regard George Wallace so lightly, however.

While he feels that "Wallace cannot possibly win" the Presidency for himself, he could conceivably hurt Nixon's chances:

By throwing the election into the 'Democrat-controlled House of Representatives, or manipulate the choice of the next President by controlling the electoral votes won by him if either candidate fails to win enough to gain election.

While Wallace appeals to the racists, O'Neill said, they are mistaken in their beliefs, because he has proved repeatedly that he is not and says that he is not racist.

O'Neill, a former newspaper advertising executive turned stock broker-manager, is content at this time to bask in the glory of rewarding Party work with Alyse assisting in that job while raising four children.

He'll probably be in there swinging again if called upon by the Party, but others will bear the brunt of the imminent battle.

## ANATOMY OF A CONVENTION-TIME "RIOT"

In a way, Miami's GOP Convention-time riots were like a cornucopia—a little something for everybody.

The social(ist) scientists could claim once again that white racism and society were basically at fault.

Communist cadres could revel in having had more on-the-job training in black revolutionary warfare.

Liberals could cry that still not enough had been done soon enough to placate Miami's Negro population.

Conservatives could gloat and say, "I told you so" to the oft-discredited theory that appeasement buys off trouble.

Criminal anarchists and just plain crooks had themselves a mild orgy.

Carefully timed for maximum exposure over the national media which tripped over each others wires at the Convention, and spawned by forces outside the Miami area, the riots were mild as riots go:

Three killed, approximately 300 arrested, \$300,000 damage and a yet-to-be-determined cost in extra police and National Guard pay.

The similarity between Miami's Liberty City riots and certain other so-called "racial" outbreaks is that public officials said they could find "neither Commun-

ism nor Communists to blame," although Miami has been long subjected to its share of Red-oriented propaganda distributed through the "Peace Cete... and other Communist front or Black nationalist groups such as the Black Muslims.

**It is to the credit of 99 per cent of the Negro population that they not only did not participate, but opposed the riots.**

To the Southern Christian Leadership Conference—affiliated with the Quaker-oriented Peace Center—goes the major credit for laying the groundwork for the disturbances.

Hosea Williams, the SCLC's phony, self-proclaimed war hero, continued to plan and prod at the bidding of the Rev Ralph Abernathy.

For weeks, Williams laid the groundwork, but not alone. Bernard Dyer, self-appointed "Mayor of Liberty City," poured fuel on the fire in a string of radio and other public appearances.

James Chatmon, bitter ex-SCLC official under indictment for embezzlement of public funds (only after Gov. Claude Kirk insisted that Miami's EOPI Program was not Kosher) did his best to get back at the "White Establishment."

Mike Meiselman, picked up by the

FBI for draft-dodging two days after INSIGHT On The News revealed how he was mysteriously avoiding prosecution by Selective Service and the Justice Department, was also involved.

Meiselman, like some sympathetic newsmen who helped trigger off the first incident they they were bodily removed from an all-black meeting, found out being white is disadvantageous in times like these.

The reluctant draftee reportedly led an anti-Reagan demonstration at Miami's International Airport when the Presidential candidate arrived.

Wayne Thompson, a University of Miami student and a leader of the United Black Students—a campus offshoot of the Students for a Democratic Society, an ultra-Leftist activist group—was a reported participant and leader.

Al Featherstone's role was not clearly established, but he was one of those listed as a speaker at the "Black Mass Rally" that preceded the riots.

Organizations claimed to be represented were to be the NAACP, CORE, SNCC, SCLC, Black Panthers, UBS and a new group called BATE.

Lack of representation among the delegates at the GOP Convention was a repeated alleged grievance of the Black



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"militants," who were ignoring the fact that it was Negroes who failed to register and vote Republican, thereby eliminating themselves from more representation in the GOP.

Demonstrations were organized outside the vast Convention Hall, and a symbolic mule train was brought in.

Abernathy snatched a few moments of coveted national TV coverage almost pleading with the rioters to be peaceful, while simultaneously inflaming them with subtle rhetoric.

Later, he joined with Gov. Kirk, Dade County Mayor Chuck Hall and Miami Mayor Steve Clark in what proved to be

a disastrous move to confer with the rioters at a moment when disturbances appeared to have tapered off.

Hall and Clark both admitted later that it was a mistake to meet before tranquility had been fully restored.

The mayors and the Governor had some uneasy moments at the mercy of the mob leaders, gritting their teeth as they were subjected to indignities, haranguing insults and vituperation.

Hall stated later that he wished he had a tape recorder to play back Abernathy's not so non-violent remarks.

Addressing what he thought to be an off-the-record meeting of the Coral Gables Jaycees, Hall made some statements about shooting rioters and looters which he denied when they appeared in print in the *Coral Gables Times* and *Guide*.

Again, in a *Miami News* story, he equivocated and said he meant he approved killing of rioters only if they threatened the safety of the City, and this drew guffaws from some of the more than 50 Jaycees who had heard his sometimes facetious, sometimes serious speech in which he used the riots to support a move to consolidate all fire and police departments and courts in Dade County.

Hall, who then left for Moscow on "business," and Sheriff E. Wilson Purdy blamed the Miami Police Department for alleged poor handling of the riot and also cast aspersions on Police Chief Walter Headley's policies. Mayor Clark put the blame on City Manager Melvin Reese for indecisiveness and the Sheriff's slow response to calls for aid.

Ironically, Headley's "When the looting starts, the shooting starts" policy which received national publicity, had been quietly pre-empted by the politicians, acquiescing to the pressure of the militants and civil rights activists.

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
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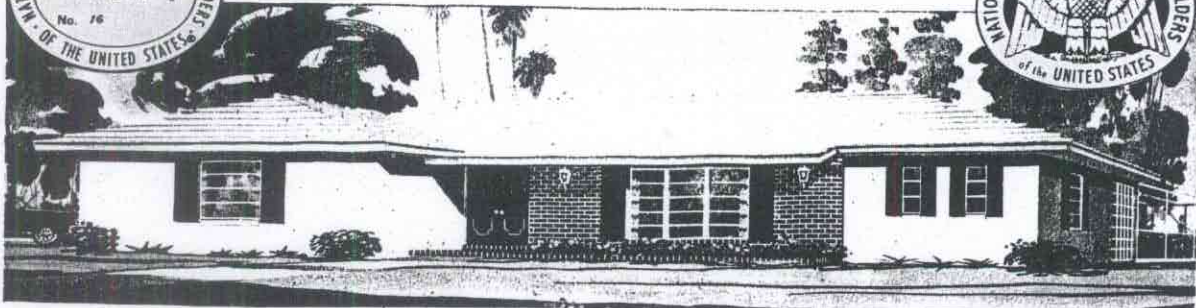

name people, to render them necessary assistance in the just struggle against American invaders.

We are also concerned over the fact that the situation in the Middle East continues tense as the result of the aggressive policy of Israel's ruling circles. Our parties will do everything in their power to eliminate the consequences of the Israeli aggression, on the basis of the resolution of the United Nations Security Council of November 22, 1967, and the withdrawal of Israeli forces from the occupied Arab territories.

The participants in the conference discussed the situation in Europe and point out that the growing activity of the forces of revanchism, militarism and neo-nazism in Western Germany directly affect the security of socialist states and create a threat to the cause of world peace. We shall continue to follow con-

sistently a concerted policy in European affairs in line with the common interests of European security, to rebuff any attempts to revise the results of World War II and to break the frontiers that have taken shape in Europe; we shall continue to insist on invalidity of the Munich agreements right from the beginning; we shall continue to render resolute support to the German Democratic Republic—a socialist state of German working people, defending the cause of peace; we shall render permanent support to the Communist Party of Germany and to all forces which fight against militarism and revanchism, for democratic progress.

#### "KARLOVY VARY STATEMENT" INVOKED

The Communist parties of socialist states express their determination to

work for ensuring European security, confirm the principles of the Bucharest declaration and of the statement of the Karlovy Vary conference of European Communist and workers' parties. They are prepared to do everything necessary for calling a congress of the peoples of Europe in defense of peace in our continent. To prevent a violation of European peace is of decisive importance for preserving peace throughout the world.
