Dear Milton,

I've finally heard from Merkle Press. And I've forgotten the name of our <sup>friend</sup> ~~Communitas Press~~. Was it David? The one with the truck that runs to and from Western Maryland?

Merkle would like 2 or 3 days notice before he picks up what he can carry of my books. I doubt he can make it in one load. Their number is 832-6420. The address is 810 Rhode Island Ave., NE. I don't know if the intersecting street is 9th or not. It is on the north side of R.I. and the building in which the books are stored is directly opposite the alley at the back of the Merkle building. If there is a second person in the truck, he can park double.

The person to speak to is Mrs. Florence Tuttle. The switchboard operator will know her extension.

From Merkle to the Beltway, the best way is ~~is~~ past Catholic U to N. Capitol, cutting over to 16 at I think Riggs. This bypasses Georgia Ave traffic. 16 extended merges into Ga. Ave a couple of blocks before the Beltway. He would then go as going to Allegheny County, to Frederick. At Frederick, instead of taking I70N, he continues on the road he is on, which was I70E and has become US15 and US40, to Exit 6W, where 40W separates. If he does not know this road, he'll see the Holiday Inn before he gets to that exit. He takes it to that Holiday Inn, where he turns right to Shookstown Rd., about 1/2 miles. He turns left on Shookstown for about 2 miles. When he starts going up the mountain he starts to watch, for Old Receiver Road, it and the street-sign both on the right. Turns right on Old Receiver .3 miles to my mailbox, on the right and just a few feet before my lane. Going back less than 5 minutes to I70N, which I presume he takes going to Allegheny County.

I would appreciate knowing when he would be here so I can be sure to be here and be able to help unload. During the tax season I generally meet my wife at her office at about 6 p.m. to bring her home.
