Re Springfield airtel <sup>To Boston,</sup> 5/31/68; and Bureau  
airtel to Springfield, 5/29/68.

On 6/12/68, ALFRED KWEISON, Shipping Manager,  
Savage Arms, Inc., Westfield, Massachusetts, advised  
SA [redacted] the Stevens Model 94, 12 gauge,  
single barrel shotgun manufactured by that firm is one  
produced in great volume. As indicated in referenced airtel,  
no serial numbers are marked on the weapon and he said  
there is no way in which a recovered gun can be traced.

He discussed the problem with officials and  
engineers at the plant and it was their conclusion a  
recovered shotgun might be examined by the plant and a  
determination made that it was in fact one of their  
manufacture. However, there is no recording made of the  
component parts or assembly markings which might appear,  
and he said, regardless of the importance of a given  
inquiry, it was not possible to say when or to whom a gun  
was shipped.
