The other reason is that there is too much nuttiness there and too many nuts and I want no association with either.

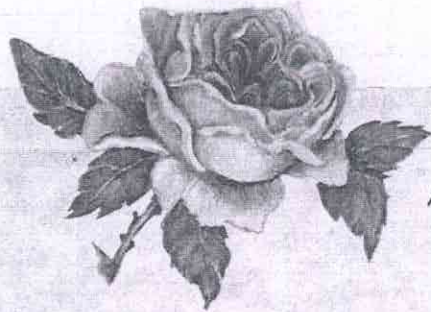
