Jacks was driving the Vice President's car. He stated that "My car had just straightened up from making the left turn (into Elm). I was looking directly at the President's car at that time. At that time I heard a shot ring out which appeared to come from the right rear of the Vice President's car."

The implication of this, as of several of the other statements, is that the shot came from not above and from behind, which strongly indicates a building other than the School Book Depository Building.

In view of the fact that thus far the Commission has shown no evidence of any examination of the vehicles or any photographic evidence, any search for evidence, anything at all along this line - the last sentence of this statement is interesting. It reads, "We were assigned by the Secret Service to prevent any pictures of any nature to be taken of the President's car or the inside."
